PRC C-377 – FAIRFAX COUNTY PUBLIC SCHOOLS (Hunter Mill District)

Deferral During Commission Matters
(Public Hearing Held on May 31, 2012)

Chairman Murphy: Now, Mr. de la Fe.

Commissioner de la Fe: Thank you, Mr. Chairman. Mr. Chairman, I have two decisions only scheduled for tonight. The first one that I will deal with is for Sunrise Valley Elementary School, PRC C-377, Fairfax County Public Schools. We had the public hearing about a month ago and we deferred decision because of a number of stormwater – primarily stormwater-related issues that were addressed by a number of speakers at the public hearing. And I thought that a month might at least give us a way of drafting development conditions that might allow this to move forward at this time. However, after a number of discussions, I believe that it would be better if this were to be deferred indefinitely and then, once the issues have been resolved and development conditions done, proceed with and then reschedule. Therefore, Mr. Chairman, I MOVE THAT THE PLANNING COMMISSION INDEFINITELY DEFER THE DECISION ONLY, WITH THE RECORD REMAINING OPEN FOR WRITTEN COMMENT, FOR PRC C-377, SUNRISE VALLEY ELEMENTARY SCHOOL.

Commissioners Alcorn and Lawrence: Second.

Chairman Murphy: Seconded by Mr. Alcorn and Mr. Lawrence. Is there a discussion? All those in favor of the motion to defer indefinitely PRC – for decision only – PRC 77-C-076 [sic] with the record remaining open for comments, say aye.

Commissioners: Aye.

Chairman Murphy: Opposed? Motion carries.
