RZ/FDP 2009-MV-023 – INOVA HEALTH CARE SERVICES

After the Close of the Public Hearing

Chairman Murphy: Public hearing is closed; recognize Mr. Flanagan please.

Commissioner Flanagan: Yes, thank you Mr. Chairman. As I indicated, there are – these proffers arrived just today, so I want to be sure that the other commissioners have an adequate time to review these over the weekend. And if you had any further comments, the record will remain open. I'd be happy to receive any further comments like those very appropriate ones I just got from Commissioner Lawrence. And I also want to take the time to review the South County Land Use Committee. They are not opposing this project, but they do have conditions for that recommendation. And so consequently I want to be sure that they're satisfied, although one of those is that building that you were referring to, Commissioner Harsel. I want them to be satisfied that this building is below 208 feet above sea level. So, with that, Mr. Chairman, I MOVE THAT THE PLANNING COMMISSION DEFER THE DECISION ONLY FOR RZ/FDP 2009-MV-023 TO A DATE CERTAIN OF JULY 22, 2010.

Commissioner Litzenberger: Second.

Chairman Murphy: Seconded by Mr. Litzenberger. Is there a discussion of the motion? All those in favor of the motion to defer decision only on RZ/FDP 2009-MV-023 to a date certain of July 22nd with the record remaining open for comment, say aye.
