COUNTY CODE AND PUBLIC FACILITIES MANUAL AMENDMENTS (TREE  
CONSERVATION ORDINANCE)

After Close of the Public Hearing

Chairman Murphy: Public hearing is closed; Mr. Hart.

Commissioner Hart: Thank you, Mr. Chairman. I want to thank the speakers for coming out this evening and I want to thank also the Commission for their indulgence with the number of questions. This is a fairly substantive package and I want to make sure we know what we're doing. Mr. Chairman, I MOVE THAT THE PLANNING COMMISSION DEFER DECISION ON THE PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO THE PUBLIC FACILITIES MANUAL, AND TO THE CODE OF THE COUNTY OF FAIRFAX, VIRGINIA, TO ADD A NEW ORDINANCE, CHAPTER 122, TREE CONSERVATION ORDINANCE, AND REVISE CHAPTERS 101, SUBDIVISION ORDINANCE; 104, EROSION AND SEDIMENTATION CONTROL; 112, ZONING ORDINANCE; AND 120, TREE CONSERVATION ORDINANCE, TO BE RENAMED, TO A DATE CERTAIN OF OCTOBER 2, 2008, WITH THE RECORD REMAINING OPEN FOR WRITTEN AND ELECTRONIC COMMENT.

Commissioners Alcorn and Lusk: Second.

Chairman Murphy: Seconded by Mr. Alcorn and Mr. Lusk. Is there a discussion of the motion? All those in favor of the motion to defer the decision only on these amendments to a date certain of October 2<sup>nd</sup>, with the record remaining open for comment, say aye.
