PCA 86-D-108 – WILLIAM WEISS

Deferral During Commission Matters

Commissioner Donahue: Mr. Chairman?

Vice Chairman de la Fe: Mr. Donahue.

Commissioner Donahue: I'm deferring this week – as in this evening. We had a good site visit at the Weiss site last Friday and I think came out with some decisions that are going to allow us get consensus, but we're going to have to do some work in order to get that done. And therefore, Mr. Chairman, I RECOMMEND THE PLANNING COMMISSION DEFER THE DECISION ONLY ON PCA 86-D-108, WILLIAM WEISS, ON ATWOOD ROAD TO A DATE CERTAIN OF THURSDAY, NOVEMBER 21<sup>ST</sup>, 2013, WITH THE RECORD REMAINING OPEN.

Commissioner Hedetniemi: Second.

Vice Chairman de la Fe: Seconded by Commissioner Hedetniemi. All those in favor, please signify by saying aye.

Commissioners: Aye.

Vice Chairman de la Fe: Opposed? The motion carries to defer that. Is it –

Commissioner Hart: Mr. Chairman?

Vice Chairman de la Fe: Yes.

Commissioner Hart: On that one, I forget now what the BZA date is, but if it's before then, should that –

Commissioner Donahue: We have to do that too. I believe the BZA meeting was set for eleventh for November 20<sup>th</sup>, if I'm not mistaken. And the deferral here – we want 21<sup>st</sup>. And therefore, I GUESS I HAVE TO ALSO RECOMMEND TO THE BZA THAT THEY DEFER THEIR PUBLIC HEARING ON THAT ITEM UNTIL SOMETIME AFTER.

Vice Chairman de la Fe: Or after we – AFTER WE MAKE OUR RECOMMENDATION.

Commissioner Hart: Second.

Vice Chairman de la Fe: Seconded by Mr. Hart. All those in favor of that motion, please signify by saying aye.

Commissioners: Aye.

Vice Chairman de la Fe: Opposed? The motion carries.
