SE 2013-HM-012 – BLUE OCEAN DEVELOPMENT, INC.

After Close of the Public Hearing

Chairman Murphy: Okay, public hearing is closed; Mr. de la Fe.

Commissioner de la Fe: We will see there are a number of conditions related to trees and what's planted. And the arborist will work on this to make sure that there is sufficient screening, as requested. Mr. Chairman, I MOVE THAT THE DECISION ONLY ON SE 2013-HM-012 –

Chairman Murphy: For a decision only.

Commissioner de la Fe: – FOR THE DECISION ONLY BE DEFERRED UNTIL NEXT THURSDAY, THE 21ST, April – I mean November 13th [sic] WITH THE RECORD REMAINING OPEN FOR FURTHER COMMENT.

Kimberly Bassarab, Assistant Director, Planning Commission Office: NOVEMBER 21ST.

Chairman Murphy: November 21st.

Commissioner de la Fe: November – did I say – what did I say?

Chairman Murphy: November 13th.

Commissioner Hart: November 13th.

Commissioner de la Fe: 13th? Oh well, I forgot the middle date.

Chairman Murphy: That was –

Commissioner Hart: Yesterday.

Commissioner de la Fe: 11/21/13.

Commissioner Hart: Second.

Chairman Murphy: All right. Is there a second? Mr. Hart seconded the motion. All those in favor of the motion to defer decision on SE 2013-HM-012 to a date certain of November 21st, with the record remaining open for comment, say aye.

Commissioners: Aye.

Chairman Murphy: Opposed? Motion carries. Thank you very much.

Commissioner de la Fe: Mr. Chairman?

Chairman Murphy: Yes, Mr. de la Fe.

Commissioner de la Fe: For the neighbors – both Mr. Brown and the others – the Land Use Committee meets at the Reston Government Center next Tuesday at 7:30. This case will be up for their decision, so if you want to be there for further comment beyond this, you're welcome to attend. They did meet last month and nobody showed up, but – so, you know, you're welcome to come that. That is open – 7:30 in the community room – the North County Government Center.

Chairman Murphy: Okay, thank you very much.
