ST09-III-UP1 (A) – COMPREHENSIVE PLAN AMENDMENT (RESTON TRANSIT STATION) (Hunter Mill District)

During Commission Matters

Commissioner de la Fe: Thank you, Mr. Chairman. We had scheduled a decision only tonight for a Comprehensive Plan Amendment related to the Reston Transit Stations. The public hearing for that was held on November 13th. Staff has been working and going through all the comments and everything we have received with me and with the Supervisor's staff. And given that this is a 114 page Comprehensive Plan Amendment with lots and lots of comments, we believe that we need a little bit more time to come up with all of the changes we need to make to take into – you know, taking into consideration as many of the comments as we can without doing damage to the overall Comprehensive Plan that the task force recommended. Therefore, Mr. Chairman, I MOVE THAT THE PLANNING COMMISSION CONTINUE TO THE DEFERRAL OF THE DECISION ONLY FOR ST09-III-UP1 – UP1 (A), COMPREHENSIVE PLAN AMENDMENT FOR THE RESTON TRANSIT STATIONS, TO A DATE CERTAIN OF JANUARY 9TH, 2014.

Commissioner Lawrence: Second.
