PCA 94-V-010 – INOVA HEALTH CARE SERVICES

After Close of the Public Hearing

Chairman Murphy: Without objection, the public hearing is closed; go to the Mount Vernon District, PCA 94-V-010. Mr. Flanagan.

Commissioner Flanagan: Thank you, Mr. Chairman. Although we do not have any testimony tonight, we do have for the record a letter from the Mount Vernon Council endorsing the Proffered Condition Amendment request from Inova Mount Vernon Hospital to remove the limitation of on-site child care to Inova employees, provided amendment the included text that will give preference to children of Inova employees. That letter was distributed to staff – by staff to the Commissioners on June 4th and is also included in your folder tonight. Inova, since then, has added the preference text to the amendment and staff, on July 2nd, is recommending approval. I agree. I, therefore, **MOVE THAT THE PLANNING COMMISSION RECOMMEND TO THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS APPROVAL OF PCA 94-V-010, SUBJECT TO THE EXECUTION OF PROFFERS CONSISTENT WITH THOSE DATED JUNE 25th, 2013.**
