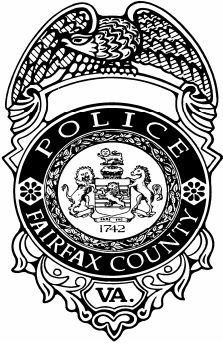

There are three sections in this report: Section I: MAJOR INCIDENTS; Section II: PROPERTY CRIMES; and, Section III: ANIMAL RELATED INCIDENTS. Sections are appropriately identified. Within the sections, incidents are organized by station, then by type of offense. They are listed alphabetically by street address.

Addresses shown indicate blocks and not specific locations. Thus an entry showing Chain Bridge Road 4100 would mean the 4100 *block* of Chain Bridge Road, not the address 4100 Chain Bridge Road.

An asterisk (*) before an item indicates that an incident report was distributed on that offense.

Section I: MAJOR INCIDENTS**SULLY DISTRICT STATION (DISTRICT 1)****ASSAULT ON POLICE AND FIREFIGHTER/ARREST**

Multiplex Drive

6300

Police arrested a woman after she assaulted one police officer and two firefighters. Police were called to a restaurant in the 6300 block of Multiplex Drive at 11:24 p.m., on Sunday, July 20 for an intoxicated patron who would not leave. They located the woman inside the restaurant and escorted her out. Rescue was called because of her condition and she was transported to Inova Fair Oaks Hospital. While en route to the hospital, she reportedly physically assaulted one officer and two firefighters. Once released from the hospital, she was transported to the Fairfax County Adult Detention Center. Sonya C. Pritchard, 38, of 14126 Red River Drive in Centreville, was charged with one count of assaulting a police officer and two counts of assaulting a firefighter. None of the assault victims required medical treatment.

MOUNT VERNON DISTRICT STATION (DISTRICT 2)**SHOOTING/ARREST**

Beechcraft Drive

3400

*An arrest has been made in a drive-by shooting that occurred Sunday, July 20. Sterling Lee Hubbard has been charged with shooting into an occupied dwelling, malicious wounding and use of a firearm in the commission of a felony for an attack on a home in the 3400 block of Beechcraft Drive in the Hybla Valley area of Fairfax County. Hubbard is charged with driving by the address and firing several bullets into the home. An 18-year-old Alexandria-area man was struck in the upper arm by a bullet. He was treated at Inova Mount Vernon Hospital for non life-threatening injuries. Hubbard was arrested late Sunday night when he entered the emergency room at Inova Mount Vernon Hospital for injuries sustained in an earlier altercation. He was transported to the Fairfax County Adult Detention Center.

ARMED ROBBERY/MALICIOUS WOUNDING

Colony Court

4500

*Police are seeking suspects in an apparent malicious wounding and robbery of two men that took place Saturday, July 19 around 3:45 a.m. An Alexandria-area man and a man from Hyattsville, Maryland, both 24 years old, were standing in front of an apartment building in the 4500 block of Colony Court when they were approached by a group of men. The men allegedly struck one of the victims with a pistol. The other victim was struck in the head. The suspects then stole money from both victims and fled the area. The injured victim was transported to Inova Mount Vernon Hospital and treated for non life-threatening injuries. The suspects were described as black and wearing dark clothing. There may have been five or six suspects.

ATTEMPTED ROBBERY

Richmond Highway/Buckman Road

At 12:09 a.m. on Friday, July 18, police were called to a residence in the 7900 block of Audubon Avenue for an attempted robbery. An investigation determined that minutes earlier the victim, a 33-year-old Alexandria-area man, was walking in the area of Richmond Highway and Buckman Road when he was reportedly approached by two men and a woman. One man brandished a handgun and the woman demanded money from the victim. The suspects assaulted the victim and knocked him to the ground. All three suspects fled into a wooded area; they did not get money from the victim. The victim returned home and called police. The victim had minor injuries that did not require treatment. The male suspects were described as black and the female suspect as white, all wearing T-shirts and jeans.

Sunny View Drive/Little Hunting Creek Drive

On Monday, July 21 at 3:15 a.m., police were called to the 8100 block of Mount Vernon Highway for a reported robbery. The victim, a 22-year-old Alexandria-area man, was walking in the area of Sunny View Drive and Little Hunting Creek. He was approached from behind by a man who grabbed at his shirt. The victim pulled away from the suspect and his shirt ripped off. The victim reportedly ran away and called police. No one was injured. The suspect was described as white, about 20 years old. He was approximately 5 feet 10 inches tall and weighed 175 pounds, wearing a white shirt and shorts.

ASSAULT ON POLICE/DRUNK IN PUBLIC/ARREST

Richmond Highway/Ladson Lane

A 30-year-old Alexandria-area man was arrested after he allegedly assaulted a police officer. Around 9:41 p.m. on Sunday, July 13, an alert patrol officer noticed a man kneeling in the roadway on Richmond Highway near Ladson Lane. The officer attempted to aid the apparently intoxicated man by removing him from the roadway but the man assaulted the officer. After a short struggle, the suspect was arrested and transported to Inova Mount Vernon Hospital. Oscar Garcia, of 2920 Furman Lane #T-2 in Alexandria, was later transported to the Fairfax County Adult Detention Center and charged with assault on a police officer, resisting arrest and drunk in public. The officer was not injured.

INDECENT EXPOSURE

Casemont Drive/Moly Drive

*A man allegedly exposed himself to an 11-year-old Falls Church-area girl on Wednesday, July 16 around 3:30 p.m. The youngster was walking to a known house near the intersection of Casemont Drive and Moly Drive when a man drove up and asked her several questions. The victim noticed the man in the car exposing himself as he spoke to her. She walked away and was not harmed. The suspect made no attempt to get the victim into his car. He fled on Moly Drive

toward Great Falls Street. The suspect was described as black, in his early 30s and clean shaven. He was about 6 feet tall and weighed approximately 160 pounds. He was wearing long, green pants and a red and white shirt. The car was described as a newer model, shiny red, four-door sedan.

*An 89-year-old man was found deceased in Lake Barcroft in the early hours on Monday, July 21. It is believed that Herbert Sultan of 6208 Lakeview Drive went for his regular evening swim on July 20 and did not return home. Family members searched and found Sultan in the water and called police. An autopsy will be performed to determine the exact cause of death. This appears to be an accidental drowning.

THREATS TO BOMB/ASSAULT ON POLICE/ARREST

Row Street

3100

A 24-year-old man was arrested on Thursday, July 17 for reportedly making threats to burn or bomb the Dar Al-Hijrah Islamic Center at 3159 Row Street. He was previously banned from returning to the mosque and police were called around 6:30 p.m. to escort him out of the property. When the officers approached Fatih Abdul-Rahim, he allegedly threw a knife at the officer, but struck a 54-year-old Falls Church-area man in the leg. He was not injured. The officers chased Abdul-Rahim through the building and briefly struggled with him before making apprehension. While inside the cruiser, he kicked out the partition during transport. Abdul-Rahim, of no fixed address, was transported to the Fairfax County Adult Detention Center. He was charged with attempted assault on a police officer, threats to bomb a building, disorderly conduct, resisting arrest, simple assault and destruction of property.

ATTEMPTED ABDUCTION

North Point Village Center

*Friday, July 18 a 13-year old girl walking in the 1400 block of North Point Village Center was approached by a man who engaged her in conversation. The two entered a coffee shop and later walked a short distance together. The man asked for a kiss and attempted to grab the girl. She ran away and called the police. She was not injured. The suspect was described as white, approximately 50 years old. He was about 5 feet tall and 180 pounds with gray hair and blue eyes. He was wearing a gray T-shirt, cargo pants and white tennis shoes.

BURGLARY OF AN OCCUPIED DWELLING

On Thursday, July 24 shortly before 1 a.m., a 32-year-old Reston woman had just gone to bed when she heard noises inside her home. She investigated and found a man standing in her living room. She engaged the suspect in conversation and he soon fled out the front door of the home. The victim was not injured and nothing was taken. The suspect was described as Hispanic, 18 to 20 years old, wearing a white shirt.

*An 18-year-old Springfield woman awoke to find a man crawling through her bedroom window on Wednesday, July 23 shortly after 3 a.m. The victim had been sleeping in her ground floor apartment in the 7200 block of Commerce Street when she felt her blanket sliding off. When she opened her eyes, she saw a man, halfway through the window, pulling on her blanket. She screamed and was not injured; the suspect fled. The suspect was described as a white or Hispanic male in his late 40s to 50 years old. He had short, brown hair and brown eyes. He was wearing a black T-shirt.

WEAPON DISCHARGE/ARRESTS

Hagel Circle

Two men were arrested after police responded to a report of shots fired on Tuesday evening. Officers were called to the 9600 block of Hagel Circle at 8:10 p.m., on July 22 after residents heard the gunfire. Officers learned that one man allegedly stood outside and discharged a handgun then left in a vehicle driven by a second man. The vehicle was located nearby with both suspects inside. Corey W. Johnson, 32, of 8009 Long Creek Drive in Ruther Glen, Virginia, was arrested and transported to the Fairfax County Adult Detention Center. He was charged with discharging a weapon in a public place. The driver of the vehicle, Randy C. Geanes, 24, of 13741 Kellingwood Circle #403 in Woodbridge, Virginia, was issued and released on a summons for having a concealed weapon. No one was injured.

ROBBERY

Williamsburg Square

An 11-year-old Lorton-area boy was robbed of his bicycle on Monday evening. The victim's mother called police at 7:25 p.m., on July 21 to report the incident. An investigation determined the boy was riding his bike in the area of Williamsburg Square when he was approached by at least 10 boys between the ages of 12 and 15. The suspects demanded the victim's bike and threatened to assault him. The suspects fled with the victim's bike and he ran home. The victim's mother located one of the suspects riding the bicycle on Hagel Circle. The suspect dropped the

bike and fled when the mother approached. The bicycle was recovered and the victim was not injured. The suspects could only be described as black, white and Hispanic.

ATTEMPTED ROBBERY

Essex Avenue

7000

Police responded to a home in the 7000 block of Essex Avenue on Monday, July 21, at 12:09 a.m., for an attempted robbery. Officers learned that the victim, a 21-year-old Springfield-area man was walking along Essex Avenue when he saw two males hiding behind a tree. One man approached the victim, displayed a knife and demanded money. The victim turned to run and both suspects chased him. The victim was able to make it inside a home nearby before the suspects caught him. No one was injured. The suspects were both described as white. One suspect was in his teens, about 5 feet 8 inches tall and weighed 160 pounds. He wore a white T-shirt, hat and jeans. The second suspect was in his 20s, about 5 feet 6 inches tall and weighed 170 pounds. He wore a purple shirt, jeans and carried a black backpack.

ROBBERY

Franklin Farm Road

*Police are investigating a robbery at a gas station that left one man injured. On Wednesday, July 23 at 11:12 p.m., police were called to the Sunoco gas station, located at 13300 Franklin Farm Road, for a robbery. Officers learned that the employee, a 24-year-old Annandale-area man, and a customer, a 24-year-old Herndon-area man, were both inside the store when the suspect walked in and immediately demanded money. He pushed the customer and proceeded around the counter to the clerk. The suspect then produced a knife and shoved the employee as well. The employee struggled briefly with the suspect and was injured by the knife. The suspect took money from the register and fled out the front door. The employee was transported to Inova Fair Oaks Hospital for treatment of his non life-threatening injuries. The suspect was described as black, with a large build. He was about 6 feet tall and 230 pounds. He was wearing a long, white T-shirt, blue jeans and a black doo-rag that covered his hair and eyes.

ANIMAL CONTROL DIVISION

Ox Road 9700 (W. Spfld District)
A deer was rescued from an abandoned water treatment plant pit at Occoquan Regional Park, 9751 Ox Road on Sunday, July 20. The animal control officer sedated the deer with a dart, and with the help of Fairfax County Fire and Rescue personnel, was able to rescue it. Shortly after, the deer recovered and walked away.
