**MOUNT VERNON DISTRICT STATION (DISTRICT 2)****ROBBERY**

Fairhaven Avenue

The employee of a 7-Eleven was robbed on Sunday, August 3 at 11:15 p.m. The clerk, a 20-year-old Alexandria-area woman was tending to a customer when a man walked behind the counter and began taking cartons of cigarettes. When the clerk confronted him, the suspect threatened her. A second suspect walked behind the counter and took more cartons of cigarettes. Both suspects fled in a white car. No one was injured. The suspects were described as black, in their 30s to 40s, each about 6 feet 1 inch tall. One suspect was wearing a red shirt, khaki pants and a black hat. The second suspect was wearing a black shirt, gray pants and a blue hat.

**SAFETY CLASSES OFFERED**

\*Women, ages 12 and above, can sign up now for an opportunity to learn how to stay safe, spot potential dangers and defend against attackers. Trained Fairfax County police officers will teach a Sexual Assault Free & Empowered (SAFE) class next month in the Mount Vernon Police District. The class will be at Riverside Elementary School, 8410 Old Mount Vernon Road, Alexandria, on September 16, 18, 23 and 25. The hours are 6:15 p.m. until 9:30 p.m. and registrants are expected to attend each of the four classes. Space is limited and classes fill quickly, so sign up today. The SAFE Classes are also held each month, free of charge, at the Fairfax County Criminal Justice Academy in Chantilly. Attendees learn physical defense techniques and crime prevention strategies that will help women overcome and handle fear, as well as give them a sense of control over their lives. A combination of classroom instruction is followed by hands-on training, taught by certified SAFE instructors. All attendees also receive a take-home reference manual. SAFE is offered to women 12-years-old and up. A female guardian must accompany those between the ages of 12 and 17. No men are permitted to be present during a class. **ASSAULT**

Richmond Highway

An employee at the South County Government Center was the victim of an assault on Wednesday, August 6. The victim is a 43-year-old Burke-area man who was working as a security guard. He was walking outside the building, located at 8350 Richmond Highway, at 8:20 p.m. when a vehicle approached him from behind. The victim turned toward the car and was shot with a pellet gun by someone inside. The vehicle and its occupants fled the area. The victim had minor injuries that did not require medical treatment.

**MCLEAN DISTRICT STATION (DISTRICT 3)****MALICIOUS WOUNDING**

Two men were injured during an altercation inside an apartment on Friday, August 1. Around 9:45 p.m. an 18-year-old Fairfax-area man was stabbed in the upper body by his roommate as he watched television. The victim and the suspect then struggled and the suspect was also stabbed in the upper body. The suspect fled the apartment and police were called. Responding officers located the suspect nearby and took him into custody. Both the victim and the suspect were transported to Inova Fairfax Hospital for treatment of serious injuries. Edward Ayala, 21, of the 9400 block of Lee Highway, was charged with malicious wounding.

**MASON DISTRICT STATION (DISTRICT 4)****ROBBERY**

Braddock Road

A 48-year-old Alexandria-area man was robbed on Sunday, August 3. Police were called to the 4400 block of Braddock Road at 2:45 a.m. An investigation determined the victim was approached by three men as he exited his vehicle. One suspect brandished a handgun and demanded money from the victim. The victim complied and all three suspects fled to a waiting car with the victim's money and personal items. No one was injured. The suspects were described as Hispanic, in their 20s.

**ROBBERY ATTEMPT**

Vista Drive/Glen Carlyn Drive

A 20-year-old Falls Church-area man was the victim of an attempted robbery on Sunday, August 3. The man was walking near Vista Drive and Glen Carlyn Drive at 2:50 a.m. when he was approached by another man. The suspect produced a box cutter and demanded money from the victim. The victim ran from the scene and called police. No one was injured. The suspect was described as Hispanic, in his 30s. He was about 6 feet tall with a medium build. He was wearing a black and white checkered shirt, blue pants and a black baseball cap.

A man was arrested after police discovered the vehicle he was driving had been reported stolen. On Saturday, August 2, at 2:55 p.m., a patrol officer stopped a car on Richmond Highway near Huntington Avenue for a traffic violation. Further investigation by the officer determined the vehicle was previously reported stolen in a neighboring jurisdiction. Johnathan Edward Coleman, 23, of 4412 Hendricks Drive in Dale City, was charged with grand larceny auto, imitation of a controlled substance, possession of marijuana, identity theft, driving on a suspended license and having defective equipment. He was transported to the Fairfax County Adult Detention Center.

ROBBERY/ARREST

Leesburg Pike

On Saturday, August 2 at around 2:30 p.m., a 33-year-old Arlington man was robbed while walking in the 5900 block of Leesburg Pike. The victim was walking alone when the suspect approached him and demanded money. The victim pulled out his wallet and gave the suspect an undisclosed amount of cash and walked away. The suspect followed and asked for more money. The victim refused and was punched in the face by the suspect who then took more money out of the victim's wallet and fled. Responding officers stopped a suspect matching the description. Belgar Goday, 28, of 3417 Glen Carlyn Drive, was transported to the Fairfax County Adult Detention Center where he was charged with robbery.

ASSAULT ON POLICE OFFICER/TRESPASSING/ARREST

Leesburg Pike

5100

On Tuesday, August 5 at 7 p.m., police were called to a store in the 5200 block of Leesburg Pike for a trespassing complaint. Officers learned that Jeffrey Vance Baldi was asked to leave the business and refused. Baldi then left the store and went into the Skyline Health Club, located at 5115 Leesburg Pike. Officers attempted to speak with Baldi in the club and he became disorderly. Baldi reportedly assaulted the two police officers before being taken into custody. He was transported to the Fairfax County Adult Detention Center and charged with two counts of assaulting a police officer and trespassing.

RESTON DISTRICT STATION (DISTRICT 5)ROBBERY/ASSAULT

South Lakes Drive

On Friday, August 1 shortly after 7 p.m., a 19-year-old woman was assaulted and robbed in the 11600 block of South Lakes Drive. The victim got off a bus and was walking on South Lakes Drive toward Shadow Woods Court when a man approached her. The suspect hit the victim and stole property from her. The suspect fled into a nearby condominium complex. The victim was transported to Reston Hospital Center with non life-threatening injuries. The ongoing investigation revealed the suspect may be known to the victim and warrants are pending. The suspect was described as black, in his mid 20s, approximately 5 feet 11 inches tall, weighing about 170 pounds. He was wearing a black shirt and khaki pants.

UNLAWFUL WOUNDING/ARREST

Parcher Avenue

On Sunday, August 3 around 10:15 p.m., officers responded to Hutchison Elementary School for a report of a fight. The suspects fled prior to police arrival but the suspect vehicle was stopped on Herndon Parkway just inside city limits. An investigation revealed that Santos Chirinos Cruz, 29, allegedly cut two Gainesville-area men, 36 years old and 25 years old, with a broken beer bottle.

The 36-year-old man was transported to Reston Hospital Center with non life-threatening injuries. Chirinos Cruz, of 1157 Lisa Court in Herndon, was arrested and taken to the Fairfax County Adult Detention Center where he was charged with unlawful wounding.

#### ATTEMPTED MALICIOUS WOUNDING

Browns Chapel Road

Police responded to a report of an attempted malicious wounding that occurred in the 1500 block of Browns Chapel Road on Wednesday, August 6. An 18-year-old Reston man was in a wooded area around 10 a.m. when he encountered a man asking for drugs. When the victim walked away, the suspect brandished a knife and attempted to cut him. The two men struggled and the victim was able to get away and run for help. He was not injured. The suspect was described as white, in his 40s. He was about 6 feet tall and weighed 150 to 160 pounds. He had medium-length, brown hair and a beard. He wore black jeans, a white tank top and a long, gray coat tied at the waist with a rope.

#### FRANCONIA DISTRICT STATION (DISTRICT 6)

#### FATAL CRASH/ARREST

Richmond Highway/I-95

\*A 53-year-old Groveton-area resident was killed by a suspected drunk driver in a two-car crash on Sunday, August 3. The crash occurred around 11:30 p.m. in the northbound lanes of Route 1 at the intersection of the ramp to Interstate 95 in Lorton. Robert L. Thomas of 3424 Spring Drive was killed when his 1996 Saturn was struck by a 2006 Pontiac that had been traveling in the southbound lanes. The driver of the Pontiac, a 31-year-old Woodbridge man had apparently lost control of his vehicle, veered across the concrete median and entered the northbound lanes striking the victim's car head-on. The victim died on scene and a front seat passenger was transported to Inova Fairfax Hospital for non life-threatening injuries. Police charged Alfredo Martinez Rivera, of 13102 Kumar Road in Woodbridge, with aggravated manslaughter and driving while intoxicated. Rivera was initially treated for minor injuries at Inova Fairfax Hospital. This is the 11th traffic fatality in Fairfax County in 2008 compared to 33 deaths at this same time last year.

#### BURGLARY OF OCCUPIED DWELLING

Edge Cliff Drive

On Saturday, August 2 at 4:25 a.m. the residents of a home in the 6700 block of Edge Cliff Drive awoke to find their home burglarized. The victims, a 48-year-old man and a 51-year-old woman, heard a noise in their home and the man went to investigate. He discovered the basement door standing open and numerous items missing from inside. It appears the suspects entered through the unlocked basement door. The suspect took money, credit cards, a cellular phone and other personal items. No one was injured.

GRAND LARCENY/ARREST

A 29-year-old Falls Church-area man was apprehended with the help of a police canine on Thursday, July 24. Richardo Zuniga allegedly stole a motorcycle from a home in the 7400 block of Pohick Road around 2:30 a.m. A neighbor saw a man black out a street light and push the motorcycle down the street. When the officer and his canine pulled onto the street, Zuniga fled. He was captured in woods nearby. He was transported to Inova Mount Vernon Hospital with non life-threatening injuries from a dog bite then on to the Fairfax County Adult Detention Center. Zuniga, of 7525 Lee Highway #75, was charged with grand larceny and possession of burglarious tools.

ROBBERY

Springfield Mall

A 48-year-old Alexandria-area woman was robbed in the parking garage at Springfield Mall at 2:20 p.m. on Tuesday, August 5. The victim was standing at the elevator on the second level of the parking garage, waiting for the doors to open when she was approached by two men. One of the men grabbed her purse while the victim held onto it. After a short struggle, the straps broke and the suspects fled with the purse. Mall security officers heard the victim scream and came to her aid. The victim was treated at the scene for non life-threatening injuries. Both suspects were described as black, in their 40s. They were about 5 feet 8 inches tall and 160 pounds. One suspect was wearing a striped, cream-colored shirt, shorts and a baseball cap. The other suspect was wearing dark jeans and a T-shirt.

suspect fled with an undisclosed amount of cash. No one was injured. The suspect was described as white, in his 20s. He wore a black shirt, dark pants and what appeared to be a white T-shirt covering his face.

### INDECENT EXPOSURE

Burke Commons Drive

\*Police are investigating a reported indecent exposure in the Burke area. On Tuesday, July 29 at 6:30 p.m. officers were called to the 6000 block of Burke Commons Drive. An investigation determined that two Burke-area girls, 15 and 16 years old, were walking through a parking lot when they were approached by a man in a car. The man attempted to speak with the girls and they turned toward him. The victims quickly realized the man was exposing himself inside the car and ran away. The suspect was described as black, 30 to 40 years old. The car was described as a gold, older-model four-door sedan. Police are investigating the possibility that this incident may be related to a suspicious person report that was taken on Thursday, July 31. In that case, a 15-year-old Burke-area girl was walking in the area of Roberts Parkway and Premier Court at 5:45 p.m. when she was approached by a man in a car. The man attempted to engage her in conversation but she walked away. The man was also described as black, 35-40 years old. He was bald with a goatee and was wearing a black and white button-up shirt. The car was described as a gold, older-model four-door sedan.
