An asterisk (*) before an item indicates that an incident report was distributed on that offense.

Section I: MAJOR INCIDENTS**SULLY DISTRICT STATION (DISTRICT 1)****ROBBERY**

Billingsgate Lane/Easling Court

*Police are investigating a robbery that occurred near the intersection of Billingsgate Lane and Easing Court in the Centreville area on Thursday, July 10, around 12:41 a.m. The victim, a 48-year-old Centreville-area man, was approached by three men, one armed with a gun. The suspects pushed the man from behind, causing him to fall to the ground, then demanded the victim's property. One of the suspects pointed a gun at him. The suspects fled with the victim's wallet, watch and iPod. The victim suffered minor injuries. One of the suspects was described as white or Hispanic about 6 feet tall, wearing a white shirt and blue jeans. The second suspect was described as approximately 6 feet tall, wearing a black shirt. Both suspects covered their faces with handkerchiefs. No description could be provided for the third suspect.

MOUNT VERNON DISTRICT STATION (DISTRICT 2)**ROBBERY**

Richmond Highway

An employee of a GNC store, located at 7696 C Richmond Highway, was robbed Thursday morning just after opening the store. The 62-year-old woman was behind the counter at 10:10 a.m. on July 10 when a man entered and requested an item from a display case. The woman began to ring up the sale as the man grabbed the item and began to run out of the store. The victim gave chase and the suspect pushed her away. He fled on a red and black bicycle. The victim was not injured. The suspect was described as black, 17 to 25 years old. He was about 6 feet tall and skinny, with dread locks to his shoulders. He was wearing a black bandanna, black T-shirt, black baggy shorts and black and white sneakers.

BURGLARY

Poag Street

A 57-year-old woman arrived home Thursday evening and interrupted a burglary in progress. The victim returned to her home, located in the 2800 block of Poag Street, at 4:50 p.m. on July 10. As she unlocked the front door she heard a noise inside. She looked through the window and saw a man running out the rear of her home. The victim immediately called police. An investigation determined the suspect entered the house by prying open a deadbolt lock on the rear door of the home. Numerous personal items in the house were in disarray but it appeared the suspect fled without taking anything. There was no description of the suspect.

ELUDE LAW ENFORCEMENT/GRAND LARCENY/DRIVING ON REVOKED

Richmond Highway/Beacon Hill Road

Police arrested a 28-year-old man after brief vehicle and foot pursuits on Friday evening. Around 11:06 p.m. on July 11, a patrol officer was alerted to a stolen vehicle traveling north on Richmond Highway near Lockheed Boulevard. The driver of the vehicle began to speed away and the officer began a pursuit. After a short distance the driver jumped from the vehicle and ran. An officer gave chase and located the suspect hiding in a dumpster. Marcus A. He was charged with eluding a law enforcement officer, grand larceny and driving on a revoked driver's license.

Police were called to the front of the Rincon Catracho store, at 2913 Arlington Drive, for a fight on Thursday evening. Officers responded at 10:11 p.m. on July 10 and located an injured man on the ground outside. He was transported to Inova Fairfax Hospital for injuries sustained in the fight. An investigation determined the victim and his friends were drinking inside the store when words were exchanged with another group of people. The argument moved outside and escalated. The fight broke up prior to the arrival of officers. Adonay Gonzalez-Gutierrez, 40, of 2625 Arlington Drive #202 in Alexandria was arrested for drunk in public during the course of the investigation. He was transported to the Fairfax County Adult Detention Center.

* Police are investigating an apparent burglary that occurred while the homeowner was asleep inside. On Saturday, July 12 at 1 p.m. the owner, a 52-year-old McLean-area woman, called police to report the burglary. An investigation determined the victim awoke around 9 a.m. that same morning and discovered her dog missing and her back gate open. She located her dog outside. Upon re-entering the home, located in the 1300 block of McCay Lane, she saw that several items including her purse and a laptop computer were missing. It appeared that between 6:30 a.m. and 9 a.m. the suspect entered the home through two locked garage doors. The victim's credit cards were used at several locations in the McLean area that morning.

MALICIOUS WOUNDING

Patrick Henry Drive

* Three men were shot while standing outside the El Catrin restaurant at 2930 Patrick Henry Drive, shortly before midnight Saturday, July 12. A man armed with two handguns approached the front door of the restaurant and fired several rounds, striking each of the three victims. Preliminary investigation has determined that the suspect got into an argument with another man inside the restaurant and was escorted out by security. Within approximately 30 minutes, the suspect returned to the parking lot and allegedly shot the victims. The suspect then turned and fled in an unknown vehicle toward Arlington Boulevard. All three victims were transported to Inova Fairfax Hospital; one, a 52-year-old Arlington-man, sustained life-threatening injuries. A second victim is a 23-year-old, from the Falls Church-area. The third victim is a 25-year-old, whose address is unknown at this time. The suspect in this case has been identified as Vitalino Gomez-Carreto, 23, of no fixed address. He is Hispanic, approximately 5 feet 6 inches tall and weighs about 150 pounds. He has black hair and brown eyes. An arrest warrant has been obtained, charging Gomez-Carreto with malicious wounding.

PEEPING

John Marshall Drive

A 40-year-old man was arrested after police observed him peeping into a window. On Saturday, July 12, at 11:10 p.m. two officers on foot patrol observed the man standing on an air conditioning unit, looking into the window of an apartment in the 2900 block of John Marshall Drive. An investigation determined the person inside did not know the suspect. Jose Felipe Cruz, of 3802 14th Street in Washington, D.C., was arrested and charged with one felony count of peeping.

Derogatory words and pictures were spray painted on several walls of an elementary school. Between Friday, July 4 at 5 p.m. and Monday morning at 9:30 a.m. an unknown person(s) vandalized the outside walls of the school. The Fairfax County Police Department recognizes the potential harm that bias crimes and incidents can have in a community and consequently encourages people to report them. WEAPON/CHILD NEGLECT

*Police responded to reports of gunfire in the 6300 block of King Louis Drive in the Lincolnia-area, on Wednesday, July 16 shortly before 6 a.m. Officers located and interviewed three suspects in that area and eventually placed them under arrest. Information was gathered about a fight that had taken place moments earlier between several people at the King Louis Drive address; including the firing of an assault style weapon. An investigation led officers to a home in the 6200 block of Everglades Drive. An AK-47 style assault rifle and a small marijuana grow operation were discovered and seized from the home. Two additional arrests were made at that time. Marcos Benavides, 18, of 1211 South Thomas Street in Arlington; Kevin Yarborough, 20, of 6303 King Louis Drive in Alexandria; and James Johnson, 25, of 15337 Watermill Terrace in Woodbridge were all charged with being drunk in public. John Anthony Palacios, 18, of 6225 Everglades Drive in Alexandria was charged with distribution of marijuana and child neglect. Gustavo Adolfo Palacios, 20, also of the Everglades Drive address was charged with discharging a firearm, manufacture and distribution of marijuana, possession of a firearm while possessing illegal drugs, concealed weapon and child neglect. The child neglect charges stem from the storage of the assault rifle in a child's bedroom.

Police are investigating a burglary in the 2900 block of Franklin Oaks Drive. The victim, a 64-year-old Oak Hill woman, called police on Monday, July 14 at 12:25 p.m. to report the burglary. Responding officers determined the victim arrived home minutes earlier and discovered the rear door to her home had been forced open. Nothing of value appeared to be missing. Further investigation developed a suspect and charges are pending.

ROBBERY/BURGLARY

Castle Rock Square

Police responded to a burglary and robbery that occurred in the 2200 block of Castle Rock Square in the Reston area on Wednesday, July 16, around 10 p.m. The victim of the robbery, a 17-year-old Reston-area man, was assaulted by the suspect who demanded his backpack. The suspect was successful in taking the victim's backpack. No weapon was displayed during the robbery which occurred just prior to police being called to a burglary in the same area. The burglary victim, a 24-year-old Reston-area man, was walking to his residence when followed by the suspect. When the victim opened the door of his residence the suspect forced his way in and attempted to assault him. Neither victim was seriously injured. Several officers checked the area and found a suspect. The suspect matched the description and was identified by both victims. Justin T. Anderson, 20, of Germantown, Maryland, was arrested and transported to the Fairfax County Adult Detention Center. He was charged with burglary with the intent to assault, robbery, and wearing a mask in certain places.

FRANCONIA DISTRICT STATION (DISTRICT 6)**POSSIBLE CHILD ABUSE**

Kingstowne Village Parkway

*Detectives are seeking witnesses in a reported child abuse case that occurred on Friday, June 27 around 7:30 p.m. That evening police were called to the Noodles and Company restaurant, located at 5900 Kingstowne Village Parkway, for suspected child abuse. Officers were directed to a 34-year-old Springfield-area woman and her 4-year-old son who were inside the restaurant. An investigation determined that a patron alerted employees after the woman allegedly struck the child. Police were called when she began shouting at the boy. Officers released the child to another family member after discovering numerous bruises on his body. The investigation is ongoing. Detectives would like to speak with anyone who may have been in the restaurant or observed the incident take place that evening. The woman is described as white, about 5 feet 5 inches tall and 350 pounds. She had long brown hair and was wearing a T-shirt and blue stretch pants.

MALICIOUS WOUNDING/DOMESTIC VIOLENCE

Edsall Road

Police were called to a home in the 6500 block of Edsall Road early Saturday morning after a domestic dispute left one man injured. Officers responded to the home around 12:30 a.m. on July 5 and located the victim, a 26-year-old Alexandria-area man, inside the home. An investigation determined the victim and another family member were involved in an argument earlier in the evening. The dispute escalated into a physical confrontation between the two. Juan J. Barrios, 34, of the 6500 block of Edsall Road, was arrested and charged with malicious wounding. He was transported to the Fairfax County Adult Detention Center. The victim was treated at the scene for non life-threatening injuries.

Rock Ridge Lane

On Sunday, July 6 at 10:30 a.m. police were called to a home in the 7100 block of Rock Ridge Lane for an assault. Officers located the victim, a 20-year-old Alexandria-area man, inside the home on the floor. He was transported to Inova Fairfax Hospital for treatment of serious injuries. An investigation determined that earlier that same morning a female acquaintance of the victim knocked on his front door. The victim invited the woman inside. She entered and four male suspects followed her in. The male suspects assaulted the victim then all five suspects fled. The investigation continues.

A 44-year-old woman was reportedly awoken by a man in her bedroom around 9:30 a.m. The suspect bound the woman and led her through the home on an apparent search for money. He then locked her in a bathroom and continued his search. He fled a short time later. The victim was not seriously injured. The suspect was described as having a dark complexion. He wore a black mask, black T-shirt and blue jeans. He was approximately 5 feet 10 inches tall and weighed approximately 180 pounds.

ATTEMPTED BURGLARY OF AN OCCUPIED DWELLING

Officers learned the three teenage female occupants were alone in the home when a teenage boy walked up to their front door. He knocked loudly and kicked the door. The lock on the rear door was broken and the door was slightly ajar but it did not appear the suspect entered the home. The suspect was described as Hispanic, 13 to 14 years old.
