Section I: MAJOR INCIDENTS**SULLY DISTRICT STATION (DISTRICT 1)****BURGLARY/ GRAFFITTI**

Sully Park Drive 5500

On Friday, January 2 around 12:30 p.m. police were called to Stone Middle School, located at 5500 Sully Park Drive, for an apparent burglary. Officers met with school security and determined that around 3:30 a.m. on Thursday, January 1, unknown persons entered the school through an unsecured roof hatch. Inside, they damaged computer and telephone lines in a mechanical room. The suspects also spray painted derogatory words and images in the gymnasium. No suspect information is available.

ROBBERY/ MALICIOUS WOUNDING

Sara Marie Terrace 6000

An 18-year-old Clifton-area woman was assaulted and robbed on Monday, January 5. Around 8:50 p.m. the woman parked her car in the 6000 block of Sara Marie Terrace and began walking toward an acquaintance's home. She noticed a man with a ski mask covering his face running out of the wood line. The man ran at her and struck her several times with some type of bottle. He took her purse and fled on foot. The victim was treated at the scene for her minor injuries. The suspect was described as about 6 feet tall with a medium build. He was wearing a black, long-sleeve shirt, blue jeans and a black ski mask.

*A 62-year-old Alexandria-area man was robbed Thursday, January 1 around 8:30 p.m. in the 3900 block of San Leandro Place. Two men approached the victim and demanded money. The victim handed over an undisclosed amount of money and the suspects fled. There were no injuries. The suspects were described as black, between 20 and 25 years old. Both suspects were around 6 feet tall and 160 pounds. Both suspects wore black ski masks. One wore a white jacket with red stripes down both sides. The other suspect wore a navy blue jacket. *A 50-year-old Falls Church man working as a teller at the Wachovia Bank located at 1300 Chain Bridge Road was robbed on Monday, January 5 shortly before 10 a.m. Two men entered the bank displaying handguns, sequestered bank employees in a room and demanded money. An undisclosed amount of cash was taken and nobody was injured. The suspects fled in a gold car, believed to be a Chrysler Sebring, with unknown Virginia tags. The suspects were both described as tall, black males, in their 20s. They were wearing dark clothing and black masks covering their faces. BURGLARY OF OCCUPIED DWELLING/ SEXUAL ASSAULT

Dartford Drive

*Police are investigating a burglary and sexual assault that occurred on Monday, January 5. Police were called to an apartment in the 7300 block of Dartford Drive around 3:15 p.m. for a reported burglary of an occupied dwelling. Officers determined a 24-year-old Mclean-area woman was asleep in the apartment and was awakened by a man pulling on her. She struggled with the suspect as he pulled her to the ground and attempted to remove her clothing. The victim screamed and the suspect fled out the front door of the apartment. The victim had no apparent injuries. An investigation determined the suspect entered the apartment by breaking out a window. The suspect was described as Hispanic, in his 20s. He was about 5 feet 6 inches tall with a slim build. He had curly, shoulder-length, black hair and a light moustache. He was wearing a black and white athletic jacket with stripes, blue jeans and white shoes. ATTEMPT MALICIOUS WOUNDING/ ARREST

Oakview Gardens Drive

A 22-year-old Falls Church-area man was injured on Saturday, January 3, after two men assaulted him. The victim was walking along Oakview Gardens Drive around 2:27 a.m. when he encountered the two suspects. After a brief conversation, the two suspects struck the victim

numerous times and one suspect attempted to cut the victim with a knife. The victim was able to break free and ran to an apartment for help. An investigation led to the arrest of Henry Alexander Herrera, 20, of 6822 Westmoreland Road in Falls Church and Miguel Angel Vicra, 19, of 801 South Greenbrier Street #216 in Arlington. Both suspects were transported to the Fairfax County Adult Detention Center. Herrera was charged with attempt malicious wounding, simple assault and disorderly conduct. Vicra was charged with attempt malicious wounding and simple assault. The assault may have been gang related.

ROBBERY

Lafitte Court

4700

A pizza delivery man was robbed on Wednesday, January 7. The victim, a 24-year-old Alexandria man, arrived at a townhouse in the 4700 block of Lafitte Court around 8:53 p.m. to make a delivery. A teenage boy answered the door then walked away and made a phone call. Two men subsequently approached the victim from the street, pushed him inside and implied a gun as they demanded money. The victim relinquished an undisclosed amount of cash and all three suspects fled. The first suspect was described as Hispanic or white, between 15 and 17 years old. He was about 5 feet 1 inch tall and 120 pounds, with short, black hair and wore a light colored, hooded sweat shirt. The other two suspects were described as black, in their early 20s. They were about 5 feet 9 inches tall, 160 pounds and wore black, hooded sweat shirts. The victim was not injured.

DESTRUCTION OF PROPERTY/UNDERAGE POSSESSION OF ALCOHOL/ARREST

Hunters Square Court

Two teenage boys were arrested for alleged underage drinking on Sunday, December 14. Police responded to the 2300 block of Hunters Square Court for a report of two people possibly tampering with parked vehicles. Officers located a 17-year-old Reston boy and a 17-year-old Leesburg boy nearby and determined they had been drinking alcoholic beverages. They were subsequently taken into custody and further investigation revealed that one of the boys had spray painted various properties throughout the area. Both boys were released to their parents on summonses for underage possession of alcohol. One felony and five misdemeanor petitions for destruction of property were also obtained for the Reston teenager.

FATAL CRASH

Rock Chapel Road

1300

*Police are investigating a single vehicle crash that left one man dead. On Thursday, January 1 around 2:24 a.m., police responded to the area of Dranesville Road and Powells Tavern Place for a vehicle that reportedly struck a fence and fled. Officers did not find the striking vehicle. Later that same morning, around 9:51 a.m. officers were again called to the same area for a vehicle that crashed through a fence. Officers located the vehicle, a 1997 Mazda, in the backyard of another home in the 1300 block of Rock Chapel Road. It appears the vehicle was traveling north on Dranesville Road. Just after Powells Tavern Place, the driver lost control and crossed

over the median into the southbound lanes. The car struck the curb, rolled through two fences, struck a house and came to rest. The house was unoccupied at the time. The driver, 31-year-old Joseph Taylor of 13338 Pruitt Place in Herndon, was pronounced dead at the scene.

A 19-year-old Reston woman was the victim of an apparent robbery on Saturday, January 3. Around 6:35 p.m. the woman and her 2-year-old son walked from a nearby store to an apartment in the 11800 block of Breton Court. As she approached the building, she was grabbed from behind by a man. The suspect took the victim's purse and fled on foot. The victim was not injured. The suspect was described as Hispanic, around 30 years old. He was about 5 feet 9 inches tall and 160 pounds with black hair. He was wearing a brown, hooded jacket, blue jeans and a blue baseball cap.

*A 23-year-old Reston man was robbed on Monday, January 5 shortly before 7 p.m. in the 11100 block of Saffold Way. The victim parked his car and was walking toward his home when a man approached, produced a handgun and demanded money. The victim had no cash, but eventually handed over his coat and cellular telephone and was not injured. The suspect fled on a red bicycle. The suspect was described as black, 25 to 30 years old. He was about 6 feet 3 inches tall and weighed between 180 and 200 pounds. He was wearing jeans, a brown, leather, hooded jacket and a tan ski cap. Before the clerks could respond, a customer drove into the parking lot and the would-be thief fled without taking anything. The victims were not injured. The suspect was described as black, 5 feet 2 to 5 feet 5, with a thin build. He was wearing a black, hooded sweatshirt, blue jeans, white sneakers and a black mask covering his face. took her purse after knocking her to the ground and fled on foot. The suspect was described as white, about 25 years old. He was approximately 5 feet 11 inches tall and 160 pounds, with brown eyes. He wore a black, hooded sweatshirt and a black ski mask with white trim.

FELONY HIT AND RUN/AGGRAVATED ASSAULT/ARREST

Cardinal Forest Lane/Gunston Corner Road

A woman driving a 2005 Lincoln sedan on Gunston Corner Road struck a 2004 Toyota Sequoia as she turned onto Cardinal Forest Lane on Tuesday, December 30 around 10:30 p.m. The driver of the Toyota, a 40-year-old Lorton man, exited his vehicle and attempted to make contact with the other driver; however, she continued driving forward. The victim chased after her as she drove up the street. The suspect struck a wooden fence nearby and the victim again caught up to her. He reached into the vehicle and attempted to make her stop but she continued driving and dragged him about 100 feet. When the victim let go of the car, the suspect drove off and he hit the pavement, injuring his upper and lower body. He was transported to Inova Fairfax Hospital and treated for non life-threatening injuries. About 30 minutes later, officers checking the area located the striking vehicle parked in the 8200 block of Springwood Meadow Lane. Warrants for the driver are pending.

*A 55-year-old woman from Beltsville, Maryland was robbed while working in the Dong Nam Market at 7904 Hill Stream Court. A man entered the store at about 3:30 p.m. on Wednesday, December 31, produced a handgun and demanded money. The victim handed over an undisclosed amount of cash and was not injured. The suspect fled on foot. The suspect was described as possibly Asian, in his late 20s. He was about 5 feet 7 inches tall and approximately 145 pounds. He was wearing a black jacket and a black mask covering his face.

Detectives are investigating the possibility that this robbery is related to two previous robberies; both of which occurred at Asian markets: one on December 20 and the other on December 21.

FATAL CRASH

Fleet Drive/ Yadkin Court

*Police are investigating a fatal crash that occurred around 2:15 a.m. on Saturday, January 3. The driver and passenger of a 1991 Dodge two-door car were driving east on Fleet Drive near Yadkin Court. An investigation determined the driver lost control and the vehicle ran off the south side of Fleet Drive. The car struck a tree and a power pole. Joshua S. Buker, 21, of 5802 Flaxton Place in Alexandria, was ejected from the car and pronounced dead at the scene. The driver, Steven M. Kowalik, 22, of 5816 Bush Hill Drive in Alexandria, was transported to Inova Fairfax Hospital for treatment of his non life-threatening injuries. Steven Kowalik was charged with

driving while intoxicated; further charges are possible. Detectives determined Buker was not wearing his seatbelt. Speed and alcohol were factors in the crash. Walter Linares Palma was charged with two counts of assault on a police officer and resisting arrest. The officers did not require medical treatment.
