**Section I: MAJOR INCIDENTS****COUNTYWIDE****FAILURE TO APPEAR IN COURT**

\*Fairfax County Police are asking for the public's assistance in locating Joseph Snow Schrotz, 19, of no fixed address. Schrotz is a white male, about 6 feet 1 inch tall and approximately 200 pounds. A bench warrant is on file for Schrotz in Fairfax County for failing to appear in court on two counts of unauthorized use of a motor vehicle and one count of assault on a law enforcement officer. Schrotz is also wanted in Loudoun County and Virginia Beach. He may be operating a light blue, Toyota Sienna minivan, stolen from the Centreville area. **SULLY DISTRICT STATION (DISTRICT 1)****POSSESSION OF MARIJUANA/DISORDERLY CONDUCT/ARREST**

Centreville Road/Upperridge Drive

Police charged a man with possession of marijuana and arrested a woman for disorderly conduct on Sunday, December 20. Around 3:16 p.m., an officer pulled up behind a disabled vehicle on Centreville Road and Upperridge Drive. While speaking to the driver, the officer noticed drug paraphernalia inside the vehicle. As the officer was investigating, an acquaintance of the suspect approached the officers and they advised her to wait in her car. The 44-year-old woman allegedly began acting disorderly as she refused repeated commands to wait at a distance. Officers took her into custody. Tasolz Campbell, of 5639 Lick River Lane in Gainesville, was transported to the Fairfax Adult Detention Center and charged with disorderly conduct. The man was released on a summons for possession of marijuana.

**MOUNT VERNON DISTRICT STATION (DISTRICT 2)****BURGLARY**

Belle Haven area

\*Police are investigating at least two burglary cases in the Belle Haven area of Fairfax County in which thieves appear to be targeting homes where residents are outside doing yard work. Most recently, a 56-year-old woman's home was burglarized on Monday, December 21 while she was outside shoveling snow, following the region's record snowfall. A thief shoved open a side door in the 6000 block of Woodmont Road around noon, trekked through multiple rooms, and stole credit cards from the victim's purse. The thief subsequently used the cards extensively in Potomac Yards retail center. In an incident on November 18, a thief entered a home in the 6000 block of Edgewood Terrace and stole credit cards from a 64-year-old woman's purse. The victim had been outside working in her yard all afternoon, and had not locked her doors. The thief, in that case too, went to numerous retail stores and used the victim's credit cards.

In both cases, the suspect is described as a male, black, and in his late 20s. He is approximately 6 feet 1 inch tall, and weighs around 200 pounds. A 27-year-old man was charged with stabbing a 30-year-old man on Saturday, December 19. Around 5:30 p.m., the two men were talking inside an apartment in the 4100 block of Wadsworth Court when they began to argue. The suspect obtained a knife, allegedly stabbed the victim in the lower body and fled the apartment. Police responded and located the suspect in an apartment building nearby. They arrested Remeo Aguilar Orozco, of 4145 Wadsworth Court #1 in Annandale, and transported him to the Fairfax County Adult Detention Center. He was

charged with malicious wounding. The victim was transported to Inova Fairfax Hospital with non life-threatening injuries.

### ASSAULT ON A POLICE OFFICER/TRESPASSING/ARREST

Police arrested a 39-year-old man for trespassing in the 4900 block of Southland Avenue on Tuesday, December 22. The victim, a 26-year-old woman, was at home when the man, an acquaintance, visited the apartment. When she asked him to leave, he started yelling and throwing things inside the home. Officers responded and the suspect allegedly threatened them. As they attempted to take him into custody for acting disorderly, he reportedly resisted but officers subdued the suspect. Two men entered the Alante Financial store; one produced a gun and demanded cash from the clerk. An undisclosed amount of cash was taken and the suspects fled. There were no injuries. Suspects were described as black, wearing black winter coats and around 5 feet 8 inches tall. They appeared to be between 35 and 40 years old. One suspect weighed around 200 pounds, and wore a beige baseball hat. The other man wore a light-colored cap. **FRANCONIA DISTRICT STATION (DISTRICT 6)****FATAL CRASH**

Franconia-Springfield Parkway/Frontier Drive

\*Police are investigating a fatal crash that occurred around 4:50 a.m. on Thursday, December 24. The victim, Robert D. Nolen, 22, of 9220 Lee Massey Drive in Lorton, was the front seat passenger in a 2009 Chevy Malibu traveling westbound on the Franconia-Springfield Parkway near Frontier Drive. Police believe the driver was traveling in excess of the posted speed limit when he struck a snow bank on the shoulder of the road, vaulted over a jersey barrier, struck a dump truck and came to rest on the driver's side. The victim was ejected and died on the scene of the crash. The driver of the crash was transported to Inova Fairfax Hospital with non life-threatening injuries. Police charged the driver, Christopher T. Figueroa, 23, of Newark, New Jersey, with involuntary manslaughter. Police believe that alcohol and speed were factors in the crash. Crash Reconstruction Detectives responded to the scene and are continuing to investigate the incident. **FAIR OAKS DISTRICT STATION (DISTRICT 8)****FATAL CRASH**

West Ox Road/Lee Highway

\*Police are investigating a fatal crash in which two women died on Monday, December 28 just before 2:30 a.m. The victims were identified as sisters, Victoria Stefan, 25, and Elizabeth Stefan, 22, of 5485 Ashleigh Road in Fairfax. They were traveling in a 2003 Jaguar, southbound on West Ox Road near the intersection of Lee Highway when Victoria (the driver) attempted to turn right onto the ramp to Route 29. The driver continued through the intersection and struck a jersey barrier head-on. Both women died on impact. Investigators have not determined the final cause of the crash, but police believe that the victims had their seat belts fastened and that speed may have been a partial factor. Crash Reconstruction Detectives responded to the scene and are continuing to investigate the incident.
