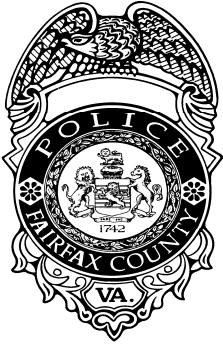

Addresses shown indicate blocks and not specific locations. Thus an entry showing Chain Bridge Road 4100 would mean the 4100 *block* of Chain Bridge Road, not the address 4100 Chain Bridge Road. This report is not a comprehensive list of every police event or larceny in Fairfax County in the stated timeframe.

Section I: WEEKLY ARRESTS FOR SELECTED CHARGES

The arrest numbers are not available this week due to technical difficulties.

Section II: MAJOR INCIDENTS**SULLY DISTRICT STATION (DISTRICT 1)**

ASSAULT Lee Jackson Memorial Hwy/Lees Corner Road, 2/7/12, 2:40 p.m. An officer conducted a traffic stop and arrested the driver, Eileen A. Griffin, 50, of Clifton. Griffin allegedly became belligerent and fought the officer. She was subsequently charged with assault on police officer, open container and driving while intoxicated.

MOUNT VERNON DISTRICT STATION (DISTRICT 2)

ASSAULT 5900 block of North Kings Highway, 2/2/12, 5:30 p.m. Officers responded to a report of an argument involving several drunk individuals. A man was being placed under arrest for drunk in public when he allegedly kicked an officer. Wilfredo Bermudez, 19, of Woodbridge was additionally charged with assault on a police officer. The officer was not seriously injured.

ROBBERY 8200 block of Richmond Highway, 2/3/12, 2:50 p.m. A man armed with a handgun robbed a pharmacy of oxycontin. Later in the evening, an off-duty officer saw the suspect's vehicle. Prince William County officers detained him. Andrew Ray Young, 24, of Triangle was charged with robbery in Fairfax County.

ROBBERY 5800 block of North Kings Highway, 2/6/12, 9 p.m. A woman was walking home when two men grabbed her. They took her back pack and fled on foot. There is no suspect description. The victim received minor injuries but did not require medical attention.

ASSAULT North Kings Highway/James Drive, 2/8/12, 9:20 p.m. A 50-year-old victim reported an unknown person threw an egg at her. The egg struck her in the back and broke, but she was not injured. There is no suspect information.
