Response time: the length of time elapsed from the receipt of a call to DPSC to the arrival of an officer at the scene

Priority 1: A life threatening event is occurring or has occurred

Priority 2: Event of serious threat to property or public order or the possibility of escalating to life threatening exists

Priority 3: Event presents a threat to public safety or convenience (traffic accident)

Priority 4: Routine or minor events, little or no threat to public safety, persons, property
