CAVEAT

On October 4, 2009 the CAD system underwent a platform change. This change incorporated an alternate call classification system causing incompatibilities between data produced from the separate platforms. Due to this anomaly, the Fairfax County Police Department has provided an estimate of CY 2009 calls based on an Exponential Smoothing (ES) technique. The above forecasts are based on call totals from CY 2003 - CY 2008.

Totals reflect a rounded number and may not always equate to the grand total listed.

*ES - In statistics, exponential smoothing is a technique that can be applied to time series data to produce forecasts.
