Youthful Driver Program



The Fairfax County Police Department recognizes the need for advanced driving skills for our youthful driver population. Teenage drivers are at a higher risk than any other age group of being involved in fatal crashes. Inexperience, peer pressure, and the increased risks that our younger drivers take is a recipe for disaster. In an effort to reach out to this very specific population group, (teens aged 16-18) we have undertaken a partnership with the community to address this issue.

The FCPD's Youthful Driver Program is a one-day, hands-on course developed to provide advanced driver training techniques to these younger drivers. Subjects that will be covered are:

- Basic vehicle dynamics
- Proper seating positions (forward & reverse)
- Proper steering techniques (forward & reverse)
- Anti-lock & threshold braking techniques
- Skid recovery techniques
- Crash avoidance
- Controlling weight transfers
- Off-road recovery techniques

These techniques are some of the same skills taught to FCPD officers. The instructors are law enforcement officers who teach driver training skills to their peers. They are ranked among the best in the nation. Trial courses have already taken place and all students were extremely pleased with the program.

Training takes place on Saturdays from 7:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. The training is conducted at the Fairfax County Criminal Justice Academy's Emergency Vehicle Operations Center located at 3725 Stonecroft Blvd, Chantilly, Virginia. It is a secured facility located just off Route 50. The track is a 1.1 mile circuit and is one of only a handful in the country built specifically for law enforcement driver training. Students will drive front-wheel drive, four-door Chevrolet Malibu's.

Cost to attend the class is \$200. Accommodations can be made on a case-by-case basis for a youthful driver who meets the target criteria but does not have the funds to attend the training.

Class Requirements

- 16 to 19 years old
- Fairfax County residents (other residents welcome if space permits)
- Possess a valid driver's license (not a learner's permit)
- Authorize a DMV record check (status only)

How to Sign Up

Contact the School Resource Officer in the high school the applicant attends. They will supply a registration form to be completed by the applicant and his/her parents or legal guardian. The completed form (must include required signatures) is returned to the School Resource Officer who will conduct a DMV check and verify the applicant meets the class requirements. They will then forward the completed registration form to the Emergency Vehicle Operations Center which will assign a class date and notify the applicant.
