Instructions for Requesting Your Criminal Record by Mail

Include ALL of the following or your request will not be processed:

- 1) **Notarized (including required acknowledgement)** statement explaining why criminal record is needed. Include **ALL of the following information:**

- Name (current and any previously used, including maiden)
- Current address
- Social security number
- Date and place of birth
- Gender and race
- Phone number or email address where you can be contacted

- 2) **Certified Copy** (*specific wording may vary by state; ask a notary public*), **notarized (including required acknowledgement)** of **TWO** of the following forms of **non-expired** identification (one must have a photo and date of birth):

- U.S. or Foreign Passport
- U.S. Driver's License or DMV Identification Card
- U.S. Military Identification Card
- U.S. Social Security Card
- U.S. or Foreign Birth Certificate ****Original** birth certificate issued by US state agency OR **original** Foreign government issued birth certificate that **MUST INCLUDE original professional translation****
