PSA 600

Larceny, 7400 Block of JERVIS ST, 3/27/11. Individual returned to vehicle to find cash and numerous items of jewelry stolen.

Larceny, 5800 Block of HEMING AVE, 3/27/11. Following a house party, a GPS, laptop, and camcorder were missing from the host's room.
