CRIME SUMMARY

PSA 600

Destruction of Private Property, 6200 BLOCK OF EDSALL RD, 5/2/11. An individual was urinating in a parking lot and then began to break mirrors off of a witness's vehicle.

Larceny, 5700 BLOCK OF CALLCOTT WAY, 5/2/11. An individual returned to his vehicle to find the passenger's side window broken and the GPS unit missing from the center console.

Larceny, 6900 BLOCK OF BRADDOCK RD, 5/2/11. An individual reported that his pistol and GPS unit had been stolen from his vehicle during his lunch break.
