## NEIGHBORHOOD CRIME CANVASS

Fairfax County Police are investigating two burglaries of an occupied dwelling in the 12700 block of Hitchcock Court and in the 12800 block of Tournament Drive in Reston. Both houses were entered from the garage. The garage door openers were taken from inside unlocked car doors. Items were taken from inside one of the homes, to include car keys. There were no injuries in either incident. Both incidents occurred on July 7 before 7 a.m.

You are encouraged to contact police if:

- You see any suspicious person or vehicle in your neighborhood.
- You have any information regarding this incident.

Remember, the information you have, regardless of how trivial you feel it may be, could be the critical link in solving this case.

Tipsters who provide their information through Crime Solvers are eligible for a cash reward of \$100 to \$1,000 if their information leads to an arrest and/or closure. Tipsters never have to give their names, just the information.
