

# Pool House Security



It's that time of year again for pool fun ! It's also time to focus on security around your pool house. Every year we experience some break-ins and vandalism at our local pools. Let's do what we can to prevent this from happening at your pool house.

## **Here are some tips on how to keep your pool house (and pool area) safe and secure:**

- Ensure all fences, gates and doors are in good working condition
- Keep all doors and gates locked after hours
- If you have an alarm system use it
- Keep the area well lit at night (add lights if you do not already have them)
- Have the area clearly posted with “No Trespassing” signs
- Advise for residents to immediately report any and all suspicious activity 703-691-2131 (non-emergency)
- Remove cash, food, drinks and any other items that may attract thieves to the premises
- Trim shrubs to allow visual inspection of the pool house
