Officer Involved Shooting Group

This group is comprised of police officers who have been involved in police shooting incidents. The function of the group is to help each other through the trauma of a police shooting, particularly to help with mental and emotional well being. They also look for training topics for their members and the Police Department to help better understand how a person reacts during the shooting incident and its aftermath. They often work with our department psychologists on group questions, but also to enhance their knowledge to help others.

Military Veterans

This group includes both sworn and civilian members of the Police Department who served in the armed forces or National Guard. The goal of the program is to provide a variety of services, support and resources for our military veterans.

Cancer Support Group
