Grease Interceptor Maintenance Log

Chapter 67.1 of the Fairfax County Code requires Grease interceptors to be cleaned as needed (67.1-3-2). Cleaning records must be maintained for three years and must be available for County review upon request (67.1-3-3). If grease interceptors and maintenance records are not properly maintained, the County may take enforcement actions to assure compliance (67.1-8).
