


2010 RALLY - TRAINING SCHEDULE



Metro Rail communications Training – June 16<sup>th</sup> & 17<sup>th</sup>

Tunnel communications solutions. Go into a vent shaft where Montgomery County Radio Cache personnel will demonstrate solutions for tactical communications while in a Metro tunnel/shaft. Lessons learned also will be shared from Sept. 11, 2001, Madrid Spain and London England. Limited to 15 students per session.
