We offer a variety of leisure enrichment classes, health and wellness programs, computer/internet access, trips, special events, and so many ways to have fun. Programs and Services

- Classes: Fine arts, exercise, crafts, foreign languages, and dancing.
- Computers and Software: E-mail family and friends, exercise your mind with mental-agility games, read newspapers from around the world, or just surf the 'Net.
- Day Trips: Shopping, sightseeing, and special outings to local places of interest.
- Mentoring: Work with young people directly or through our intergenerational programs.
- Senior Olympics: Participate or cheer on your friends.
- Social Clubs: Bridge, genealogy, Mah Jong, stamp collecting, and military veterans.
- Social Events: Celebrations, cultural performances, dancing, and games.
