

# Active Police Officers to Elect New Trustee

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## NOMINATION DEADLINE 11/8/12

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The Fairfax County Police Officers Retirement System will have a vacancy on its Board of Trustees effective January 1, 2013. The position is a four (4) year term of office, and will be filled by election from the active membership at large.

The elected Board member will attend monthly meetings of the Police Officers Retirement System Board and work closely with other County Retirement Boards, the Personnel and Reorganization Committee of the Board of Supervisors, and other county agencies. These interrelationships occasionally require additional monthly meetings. The Board of Trustees administers a retirement system with over 1,350 active members, 943 retirees, and assets in excess of \$1 billion.

Nominations must be received by 1600 hours (4:00 p.m.) on **November 8, 2012**. Nominees should submit up to a 300-word statement about why they want to be a Trustee on the Police Officers Retirement System Board. This statement may also include biographical information. Statements will be printed as submitted and distributed on all ballots. Nominations without a statement, or in excess of 300 words, will not be accepted.

Submit nominations for the Board vacancy to Robert L. Pre-printed postage-paid ballots will be mailed to the home address of all active members of the Police Officers Retirement System at the close of the nomination process. Ballots must be received at the Retirement Agency by 12 noon on December 26, 2012. The winner will be notified December 31, 2012 and the new trustee will take office January 1, 2013.
