Three public forums were held in November and we invite you to participate in this fourth and final hearing to help identify housing and other human service needs to be addressed in the Fairfax County FY 2011-2015 Five Year Consolidated Plan. Summaries of comments received at the forums and this hearing and updates on the planning process will be posted periodically on the Fairfax County Redevelopment and Housing Authority website at: <http://www.fairfaxcounty.gov/rha>. The final plan will be approved by the Board of Supervisors and submitted to the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) in May 2010.

The hearing is open to the public and the CCFAC is particularly interested in hearing from those who did not attend one of the previous forums. The CCFAC also is particularly interested in hearing from citizens that are in need of or are receiving housing and/or other assistance; local non-profit, faith-based or private enterprise providers of direct services to low-income individuals and families; and advocates for such services.

Participants will have an opportunity to make presentations to the CCFAC about the housing, community development and human services needs of county, as well as to provide input on how well the county is performing in meeting these needs. Although **the CCFAC invites input on any topic**, presentations on specific topics and issues related to the following are encouraged:

- Affordable Housing, Community and Economic Development
- Helping the Homeless and Persons with Special Needs
- Fair Housing

Note: The public hearing is not for the purpose of obtaining specific requests for funding.

This public hearing is being held to receive comments on Fairfax County's Consolidated Plan performance and to receive public input on housing and community development needs in Fairfax County for the development of the Fairfax County Five-Year Consolidated Plan for FY 2011 – FY 2015. The Consolidated Plan is a federal requirement from HUD that combines the broad planning requirements of the National Affordable Housing Act of 1990 with the annual applications and reporting for the HUD-funded programs that are administered by Fairfax County. Information from this public hearing also will be used to prepare the Consolidated Plan One-Year Action Plan for FY 2011 and to educate the residents of Fairfax County concerning community needs. Each speaker will be allowed three minutes to address the Committee unless you are the representative of an official Fairfax County Board, in which case you will be allowed five minutes.
