RESOLUTION PROVIDING FOR THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE COMPREHENSIVE
COMMUNITY CORRECTIONS ACT FOR LOCAL RESPONSIBLE OFFENDERS, THE
PRETRIAL SERVICES ACT AND THE ESTABLISHMENT OF THE
FAIRFAX COMMUNITY CRIMINAL JUSTICE BOARD

Whereas, the City of Fairfax , Virginia (“City of Fairfax” or “Party”), and the County of Fairfax, Virginia (“County of Fairfax” or “Party”), are political subdivisions of the Commonwealth of Virginia; and

Whereas, the Virginia General Assembly has adopted legislation entitled the Comprehensive Community Corrections Act for Local Responsible Offenders, Article 9 (§ 9.1-173 et. seq.) of the Code of Virginia and the Pretrial Services Act, Article 5 (§ 19.2-152.2 et seq.) of the Code of Virginia, both of which were effective July 1, 1995; and

Whereas, §§ 9.1-174 and 19.2-152.2 of the Code of Virginia require counties and cities approved for a jail project pursuant to § 53.1-82.1 to develop and establish services in accordance with both Acts; and

Whereas, §§ 9.1-178 and 19.2-152.5 of the Code of Virginia require that each county and city establishing and operating local community-based probation and pretrial services establish a Community Criminal Justice Board, and in the case of multi-jurisdictional efforts, that each jurisdiction mutually agree upon the number of appointments to said board.

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED that the City of Fairfax and the County of Fairfax jointly agree to implement the services and programs required by the Comprehensive Community Corrections Act for Local Responsible Offenders and the Pretrial Services Act with, pursuant to § 9.1-183, the Fairfax County Executive acting as the administrator and fiscal agent on behalf of the participating localities:

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City of Fairfax and the County of Fairfax establishes the Fairfax Community Criminal Justice Board; that said board shall fulfill its responsibilities pursuant to § 9.1-180; and shall be composed of the following members, pursuant to § 9.1-178 of the Code of Virginia.

- One representative of the governing bodies of each participating jurisdiction
- A circuit court judge representing the nineteenth Judicial Circuit as agreed upon by the judges of said circuit
- A judge of general district court, representing the Nineteenth Judicial District as agreed upon by said judges of the district
- A judge of the juvenile and domestic relations district court representing the Nineteenth Judicial District as agreed upon by the said judges of the district
- The Chief Magistrate for the Nineteenth Judicial District
- The Commonwealth’s Attorney for the Nineteenth Judicial District
- The Public Defender for the Nineteenth Judicial District
- The Sheriff for the Nineteenth Judicial District
- The Fairfax City Chief of Police
- The Fairfax County Chief of Police
- A Fairfax City School Representative
- A Fairfax County Schools Representative
- An Administrator for the Fairfax Community Service Board

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this resolution supersedes and replaces all prior resolutions approved by the locality relating to the establishment of required services and the formation of the Fairfax Community Criminal Justice Board.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City of Fairfax and the County of Fairfax appoints;

- The City of Fairfax Superintendent of Schools
- A School Board Member for the Fairfax County Schools
- The Executive Director of the Fairfax-Falls Church Community Service Board

- The Clerk of Juvenile and Domestic Relations Court for the Nineteenth Judicial District
