






Project Limits




- **Widen the Fairfax County Parkway from four (4) to six (6) lanes within the existing median**
- **Grade-separated split diamond interchange at the Fair Lakes Parkway and Monument Drive**
- **Rebuild Fair Lakes Pkwy and Monument Dr. at Intersections**
- **Widening of the existing bridge over Route 50.**

Overview of Project – Looking North




First Year: Now through November 2011




- Ramp Construction
- Fair Lakes Pkwy and Monument Dr. Construction
- Median Construction
- Temporary Signals
- Retaining and Noise Walls

- **Detour** – No through traffic on Fair Lakes Pkwy across Fairfax County Parkway
- **Middle to late 2011**




November 2011 – First Major Traffic Switch




- All Fairfax County Parkway Traffic will be Shifted to the New Ramps
- Only through movement allowed on Fairlakes Parkway

Second Year – November 2011 through December 2012




- Bridge Construction
- Fairfax County Parkway Construction
- Continued Construction of Fair Lakes Pkwy and Monument Dr. under bridges
- Retaining and Noise Walls

- **Detour – Left Turns Prohibited**
Fair Lakes Pkwy to Fairfax County Parkway
- **Late 2011 – Early 2012**




December 2012 – Second Major Traffic Switch



- Through Fairfax County Parkway Traffic Shifted to Newly Constructed Fairfax County Parkway
- Ramps to Remain open

Third Year – January 2013 through July 2013



- Remaining contract items
- Lighting
- Signals
- Signage
- Landscaping
- No Detours
- Temporary Lane Closures

July 2013 – All Traffic in Final Configuration



- All traffic in final configuration on intermediate asphalt

Third Year – July 2013 through October 2013



- Final Paving and Striping under temporary lane closures
- Punch List

Speed Limit Reduction

- **Fair Lakes Parkway**
 - Reduced from 45 mph to 35 mph in work zone
 - Duration of Project
- **Fairfax County Parkway**
 - Reduced from 50 mph to 40 mph
 - Implemented when FCP traffic shifted to proposed ramps
 - Late 2011



Lane Closure Restrictions


- Lane Closures will only be allowed:

Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday	9:00 AM – 3:00 PM 9:00 PM – 5:00 AM
Friday	9:00 AM – 3:00 PM 10:00 PM – 9:00 AM
Saturday	9:00 PM – 9:00 AM
Sunday	9:00 PM – 5:00 AM

No Rush Hour or Day Time Weekend Lane Closures

Night Work

- Temporary Barrier Placement
- Erection of Beams and Girders for Bridges
- Earthwork Operations
- Paving



Rte 50 Bridge Pile Driving

- **Pile Driving for the Pier Foundation – Rte 50 Bridge**
 - Double lane closures on Rte 50 weekend daytime.
