**I-66 WEST RAMP TO ROUTE 50 CLOSED
OVERNIGHT NEXT WEEK**
Westbound I-66 lane closures also planned

CHANTILLY – Beginning Sunday, Aug. 23, the exit from westbound I-66 to westbound Route 50 (Exit 57) in Fairfax County will be closed from 10 p.m. to 5 a.m. Sundays through Thursdays. The closure will be in place nightly for two weeks as crews replace concrete pavement on I-66 and on the ramp.

Detour signs will be posted to direct motorists on to the Fairfax County Parkway (Exit 55), and back to Route 50.

In addition, motorists should expect westbound delays from closures on the main lanes of I-66 at the ramp to Route 50. Two lanes westbound will be closed at 9 p.m., with a third lane closing at midnight. Traffic will be able to get by on the shoulder. All lanes will reopen by 5 a.m. each morning.

Nightly westbound lane closures are expected to last throughout the project, which is scheduled to be complete in November. Additional Route 50 ramp closures also will be scheduled periodically.
