Workshop on Policy Addressing Disturbances to Environmental Quality Corridors

The Board of Supervisors has asked county staff, in coordination with the Planning Commission, Fairfax County [Environmental Quality Advisory Council \(EQAC\)](#) and stakeholders, to conduct a thorough review of the county's Environmental Quality Corridor policy as it relates to proposals for disturbances to these areas. As a starting point for discussion in advance of more formal consideration of a Plan Amendment, staff has drafted [a paper providing a detailed background regarding this issue as well as a draft "strawman" Plan Amendment](#). The Planning Commission's Environment Committee will hold a public workshop to solicit comments from interested parties on the "strawman" draft. The workshop will be held on **Wednesday, January 6, 2010 at 7:30 p.m.** in the Board Auditorium, Fairfax County Government Center, 12000 Government Center Parkway, Fairfax. The Environment Committee will consider comments received at the workshop in formulating a recommendation on this issue.
