## Free Income Tax Preparation

The Volunteer Income Tax Assistance Program provides free tax preparation services at no cost to working families and individuals in our community whose annual earned income is less than \$49,000. The program will be opening 20 sites beginning on January 25, 2011. Last year volunteers donated approximately 13,200 hours of their time to help low-income families receive over \$5.5 million in federal tax refunds. The average VITA recipient received \$1,532 in federal tax refunds and \$1,797 in Earned Income Tax Credit (EITC).

### PLEASE BRING THE FOLLOWING ITEMS:

(If married and filing a joint return both spouses must be present)

- Photo ID for taxpayer (and spouse if filing jointly).
- Social Security cards and birthdates for the taxpayer, spouse and dependents.
- If married and filing a joint return, both spouses must be present.
- Wage and earnings statements: W-2, W-2G, 1099-R.
- Unemployment compensation, Form 1099G.
- Interest and dividend statements.
- Child care expenses paid in 2010 and the child care provider's name, address and federal ID number.
- Student loan interest payments.
- Record tuition, purchase of books and/or student loan payments, 1098-E.
- A copy of last year's federal and state returns (if available).
- A check or deposit slip if you want direct deposit.
- Record of any sales tax paid on new vehicles purchased in 2010.
- Record of any real estate taxes and mortgage interest payments made in 2010.
- Record of any Economic Recovery Payment received from Social Security Administration (SSA), the Railroad Retirement Board (RRB) or Veterans Administration.
