If you worked in 2008, and earned less than \$42,000, then you may qualify. IRS certified volunteers will ensure you receive the maximum tax refund and help determine if you are eligible for the earned income tax credit.

Sites open starting January 24 through April 2009.

What Is The Northern Virginia (NOVA) Cash Campaign?

The Northern Virginia CASH Campaign provides free tax preparation services to low-income members of the Northern Virginia community. Through a coalition of libraries, faith and community-based groups,

public agencies, and businesses the mission is to increase financial literacy among low-income taxpayers.

PLEASE BRING THE FOLLOWING ITEMS:

- Photo ID.
- Social Security cards and birthdates for the taxpayer, spouse and dependents.
- If married and filing a joint return, both spouses must be present.
- Wage and earnings statements: W-2, W-2G, 1099-R.
- Unemployment compensation, Form 1099G.
- Interest and dividend statements.
- Day care expenses paid in 2008 and the day care provider's name, address and federal ID number.
- Student loan interest payments.
- Record tuition or student loan payments, 1098-E.
- A copy of last year's federal and state returns including economic stimulus check total.
- A check or deposit slip if you want direct deposit.
