**Cub Run Gravity Delivery System Improvements Project
Public Information Meeting**

The Upper Occoquan Sewage Authority (UOSA) is preparing to replace approximately 24,000 linear feet of sewer pipelines in the Cub Run Gravity Delivery System (CRGDS). This delivery system is located within the Cub Run Stream Valley Park and the proposed improvements would run from just north of Braddock Rd. to just north of I-66. This system was constructed in the 1970s and serves Western Fairfax County. Due to age of the pipes and population growth in the area served, the CRGDS does not have the capacity to

adequately handle the peak flow of sewage currently being generated.

The new pipeline will be placed in the same location as the existing pipeline. Plans for the project will be developed with advice from the Park Authority to minimize impacts to the parkland and to ensure the area is restored to FCPA requirements. Construction is estimated to begin in Fall 2007 with completion in Fall 2010.
