Stakeholders Meetings on Riparian Buffers Along Headwater Streams

The Fairfax County Department of Public Works and Environmental Services (DPWES) invites you to participate in two information gathering sessions to discuss issues related to the creation of riparian buffers along headwater streams. These headwater streams are located upstream of existing Resource Protection Areas (RPAs). RPAs are riparian buffers established around perennial streams that are protected under the county's Chesapeake Bay Preservation Ordinance. The information gathered in these sessions will be used in evaluating a regulatory approach to protecting these headwater streams. A regulatory approach will complement the recently adopted Comprehensive Plan guidance regarding the protection and restoration of headwater streams and associated buffer areas.

The information gathering sessions will be approximately 2 hours in length and begin at **7:00 pm**. Different issues will be discussed at each meeting. Thus a commitment to attend both sessions is strongly encouraged to provide continuity regarding the discussions and issues. The sessions are scheduled for the following dates and locations:
