Sully Woodlands Planning Information Session

When: Thursday, June 23, 2005 at 7pm

Where: Westfield High School Lecture Hall

The Park Authority is proposing to plan approximately 4,000 acres of parkland in the Cub Run and Bull Run Watersheds. The Sully Woodlands Regional Master Plan will address approximately 2,150 acres of recently acquired park property in the western portion of the county, in addition to 2,250 acres of existing parkland including E.C. Lawrence, Cub Run Stream Valley, and Richard W. Jones Park. This will be the initial kick-off meeting of the regional master planning process. At this planning information session, we will be reviewing site and community issues in the context of the Cub Run watershed and park and recreation needs in the western portion of Fairfax County. The intent of this information session will be to introduce attendees to the proposed process and to existing conditions. There will be future public meetings, through the end of this year, to discuss in greater detail future possible parkland uses and to listen to

community thoughts about those uses.

At the information session, there will be a brief period for questions after the presentation. Although this is not the only opportunity for citizens to present their views on this master plan, individuals or organizations are urged to attend. Comments will be accepted at the meeting or can be mailed to Angie Allen, Project Manager, Planning & Development Division, Fairfax County Park Authority, 12055 Government Center Parkway, Suite 421, Fairfax, VA 22035. This meeting is the **first** step in the planning process and will be followed by a series of focus group meetings in July to discuss natural and cultural resource, recreation, and trail issues. The input from this meeting will help us develop the draft planning documents. Those responding to this meeting will be notified of all subsequent meetings concerning this project.
