## **Annual Little Rocky Run/Alice Ferguson Cleanup**

The annual Little Rocky Run/Alice Ferguson cleanup will take place on **April 10, beginning at 9:00AM**. The meeting point will be Arrowhead Park Lane (directions below) - you can park where this road "T's" into US29 or you can park on the side of the road. From there we will divide into teams. A larger team will head upstream toward Stringfellow Road, drop off trash collected on the way up, and then proceed back downstream and drop off this trash on Arrowhead Park Lane. A smaller team will proceed downstream to Centreville Farms Road, drop off trash collected on the way down, and then proceed back

Bags, gloves, water, and pickup tools will be provided (although there may not be enough pickup tools to go around). It is recommended that you wear clothes that can take brambles, etc.

All of the trash collected will be taken to the Ox Road Landfill.

Directions to the staging point on Arrowhead Park Drive. 1. From Stringfellow Road turn west onto Autumn Willow Dr. (toward Colin Powell Elementary School). Turn left onto Arrowhead Park Lane. Go about 150 yds. and you will see us. OR 2. From Centreville Farms Road turn east onto Leland Drive (toward Colin Powell Elementary School). Turn right onto Arrowhead Park Lane. Go about 150 yds. and you will see us.
