**Great Parks, Great Communities: Provide input,
comments through Nov. 15**

There is still time to provide input on the future of your community's park system! The draft Great Parks, Great Communities Park Comprehensive Plan was released late August 2010 and four public input meetings were held in early October to gain public input on the plan. Meeting summaries and presentations are available on the project web site (<http://www.fairfaxcounty.gov/parks/plandev/greatparks>). We want your opinion to ensure that the plan reflects community values.

The plan consists of one countywide chapter and 14 district chapters. All chapters contain issues identified through the public process and strategies developed to address those issues. District chapters also contain a listing of parks currently located within that district and the classification of each. Comments on issues, strategies, and classification of parks are requested. Since the plan is lengthy, you may want to focus on recommendations for your area of the County. By using the



Input and comments can be made through November 15, 2010. You can submit comments online through the project web site or send an email to parkmail@fairfaxcounty.gov.

After the comment period ends on November 15, input will be compiled and the plan will be revised as appropriate. The revised Great Parks Park Comprehensive Plan will be presented to the Park Authority Board for adoption in the first quarter of 2011.
