Park Authority Approves Sully Woodlands Master Plan

The Fairfax County Park Authority Board recently approved the Sully Woodlands Regional Master Plan. The Sully Woodlands consist of more than 4,400 acres of parkland in western Fairfax County and is made up of land acquired in the last few years as well as existing assemblages and parks.

The plan is available online at <http://www.fairfaxcounty.gov/parks/sullywoodlandsplanning.htm> . The plan includes a range of recreational uses, both active and passive. Uses include athletic fields, trails, cultural and historic interpretation and creation of places for people to gather. Stewardship has been a major theme throughout the planning process and much of the use will be passive. The Regional Master Plan proposes management guidelines, land use recommendations, and potential next steps in the planning process.
