Welcome to the inaugural year of Sully District's Starlight Cinema. The movie nights are designed to bring the community together and nurture community spirit. The program is modeled after the Park Authority's summer concert series held throughout the county and in 2005 will provide four drive-in movies, free for the public to enjoy, on Saturday evenings in August.

Movies selected are chosen to appeal to the whole community--films that parents can bring their children to, but adults can also enjoy. The atmosphere is relaxed and informal. Feel free to bring a picnic, blanket, and chairs and visit with your neighbors under the stars. Held at Trinity Centre, Sully District Starlight Cinema is made possible through a partnership of the Park Authority, KSI/Clark Advisors (the owners of Trinity Centre) and private donations.

Trinity Centre, the site of the drive-in, is located on Trinity Parkway, off of Route 29 just west of the 28/29 interchange. The movies will be shown in the parking lot of 5875 Trinity Parkway, across from the Lifetime Fitness. E.T., Harry Potter and the Prisoner of Azkaban, Shrek 2, and Ghostbusters will all be shown on a large inflatable screen. There will be an area in front of the screen for seating. Activities, including a moonbounce and live music, will begin at 7:30pm and the movies will start at dusk. Vendors will be selling concessions and a portion of their proceeds will be donated to the Centreville Community Foundation.
