

West Ox Complex Fact Sheet

- The West Ox Complex is a partnership among Fairfax County, the Commonwealth of Virginia and the Washington Metropolitan Area Transit Authority. It will provide critical infrastructure to improve the efficiency and effectiveness of both public safety and transportation services in the county and Northern Virginia.
- The West Ox Complex encompasses approximately 130 acres in the Springfield District of Fairfax County on West Ox Road between Route 29 and Route 66. It is located on the site of the former “Camp 30” state correctional facility.
- The following facilities will be located at the West Ox Complex:
 - Public Safety and Transportation Operations Center.
 - Bus Operations Center.
 - Police Forensics Facility.
 - Virginia Department of Transportation facilities.
 - Virginia State Police Division 7 Headquarters.
- Development of the West Ox Complex will take place in phases. There are plans for growth through 2025, with additional expansion capabilities.
- Phase one at the West Ox Complex will be the Public Safety and Transportation Operations Center — PSTOC. Construction of the building will be completed by November 2007. The estimated cost for PSTOC is \$122.5 million, which includes \$102.5 for the county functions and \$20 million for the Virginia State Police and Virginia Department of Transportation functions.
- PSTOC will include:
 - Fairfax County Department of Public Safety Communications (9-1-1 call center).
 - Fairfax County Office of Emergency Management.
 - Fairfax County Emergency Operations Center.
 - Virginia State Police Division 7 call-takers and dispatchers.
 - Virginia Department of Transportation Smart Traffic Center.
- The Fairfax County areas in the PSTOC facility will total approximately 93,000 square feet. The Virginia State Police and Virginia Department of Transportation areas in PSTOC will total approximately 21,000 square feet.
- The Fairfax County Police Department Forensics Facility, approximately 33,000 square feet, will be collocated with the PSTOC facility. The estimated cost for the Forensics Facility is \$13 million.
