






Kirby Road Travel Lanes





Chesterfield Avenue Intersection Re-alignment

Construction Elements

Sequence of Construction

Phase 1: Close the WB travel Lane on Kirby Road to construct waterline relocation between Corliss Court and Birch Road, including side street tie-ins and service connections. Traffic maintained in both directions under flagging operation.

 Shift WB traffic to the center lane between Powhatan Street and Corliss Court. Install traffic barrier to construct storm sewer connection and waterline relocation at existing box culvert. (Duration: Approximately 4 weeks)



Sequence of Construction

Phase 2: Close Kirby Road WB Lane to construct drainage items, curb and gutter, sidewalk, curb ramps, driveway entrances, and utility adjustments. Traffic maintained in both directions under flagging operation.




