#### The Panel's Purpose, Structure, and Means

- Purpose: Enhance legitimacy and trust between the Fairfax County Police Department (FCPD) and the community.
- Means:
  - Review completed Internal Affairs Bureau (IAB) investigations
    - Complete, thorough, accurate, impartial, and objective
  - Provide citizens an independent avenue for making a complaint against the police
  - Make recommendations regarding FCPD policies and practices
  - Determine whether IAB investigations are "complete, thorough, accurate, impartial, and objective."

### 2023-2024 Annual Report Overview

#### **Personnel & Staffing**

- Cheryl Belkowitz elected to serve as 2024-25 Chair
- Two Panel members resigned in February and April 2024, respectively, one being the designated member with law enforcement experience (replacements pending)
- Panel's Executive Director resigned in July 2023
- Board of Supervisors hired Craig Miles as Panel Liaison in March 2024 to replace Executive Director
