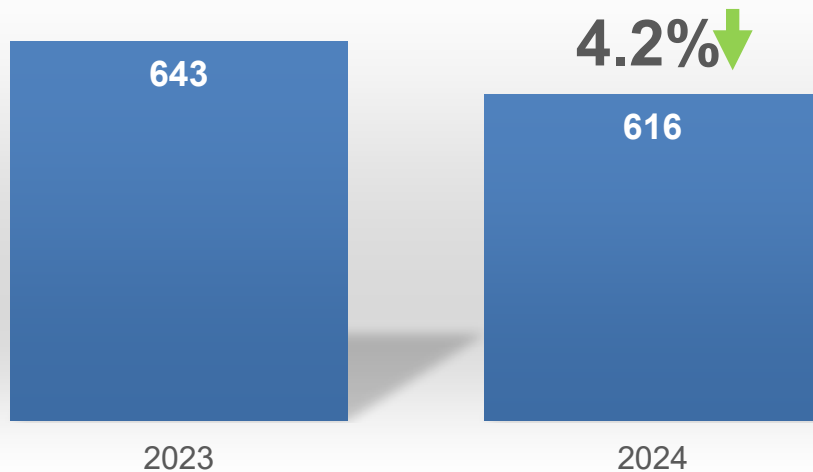

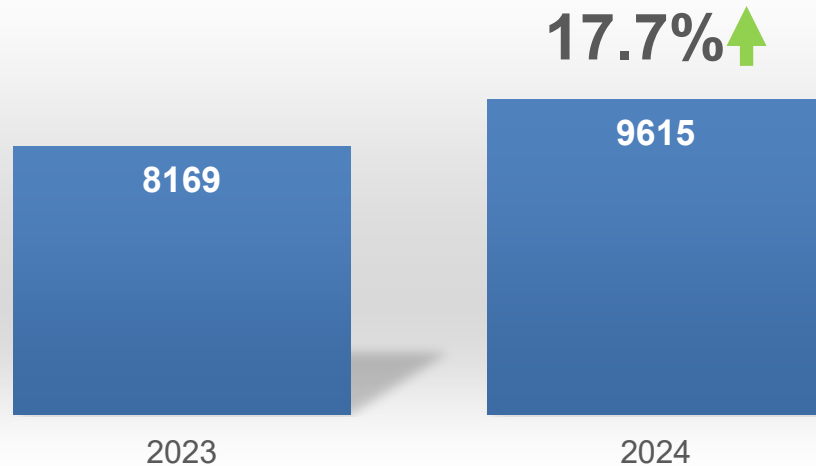

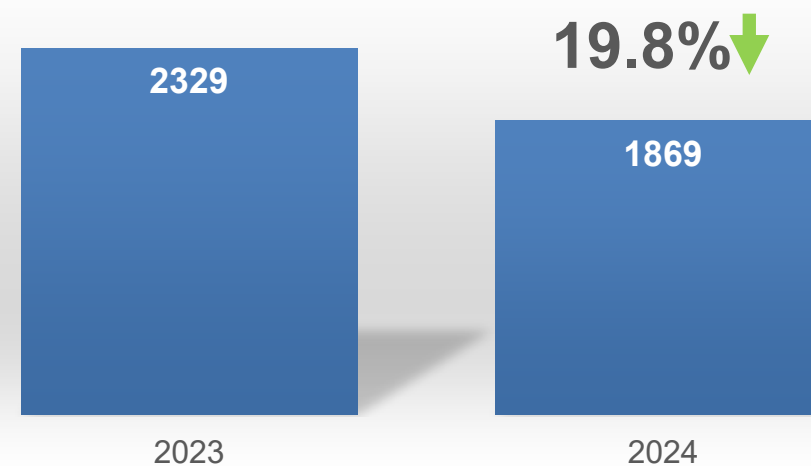

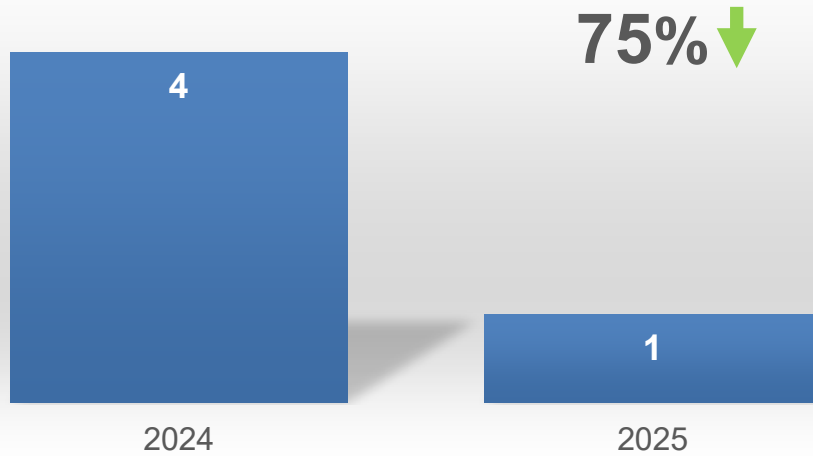

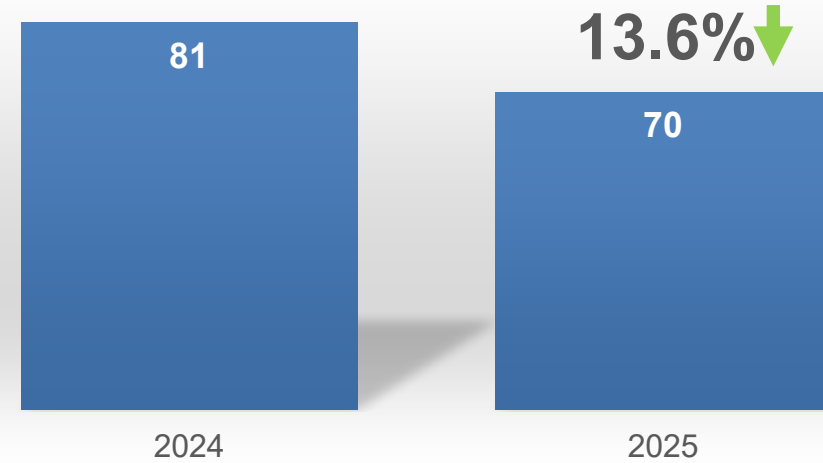

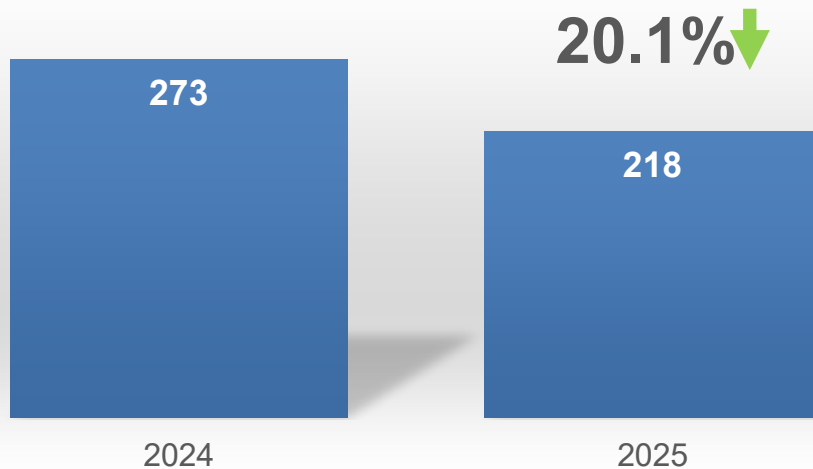

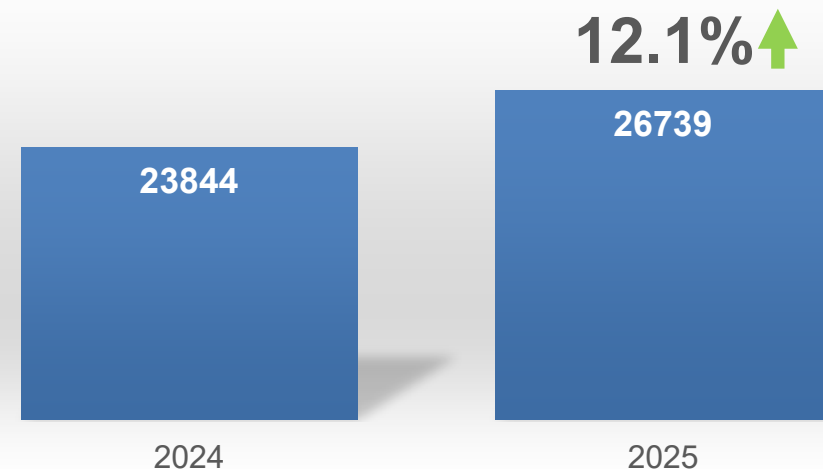

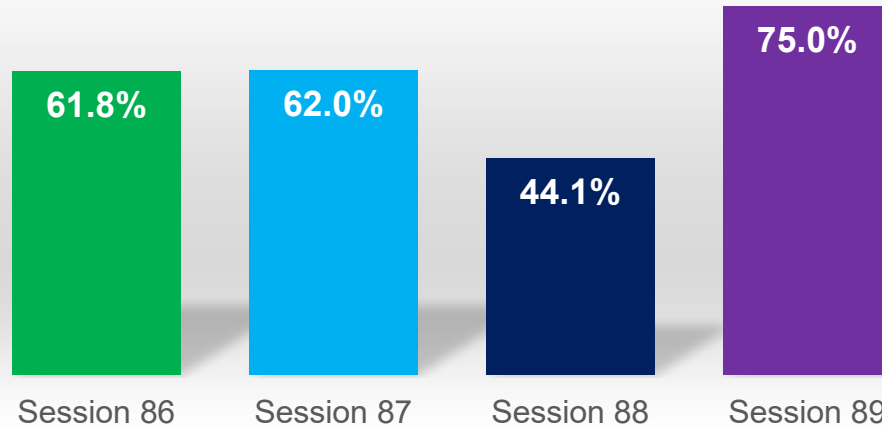


Q1 Police Officer Sworn Separations

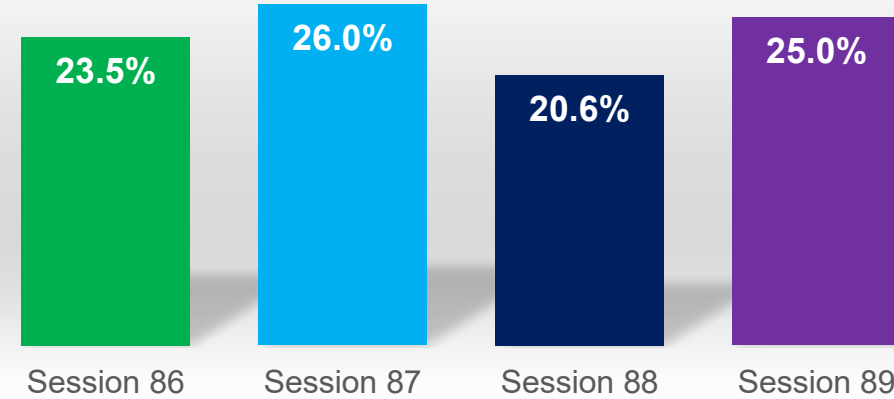

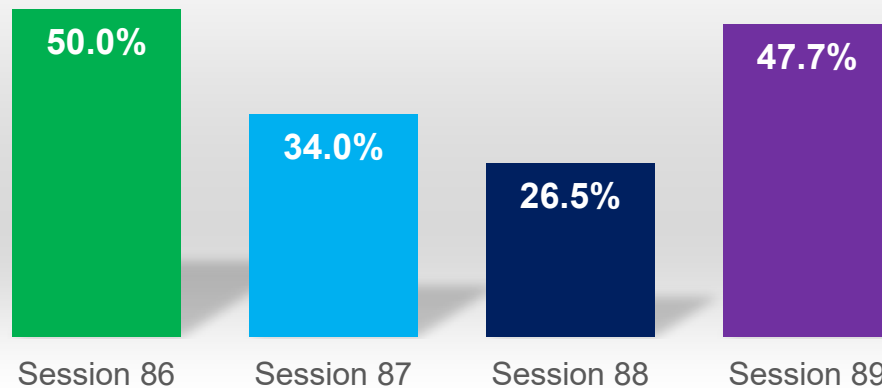

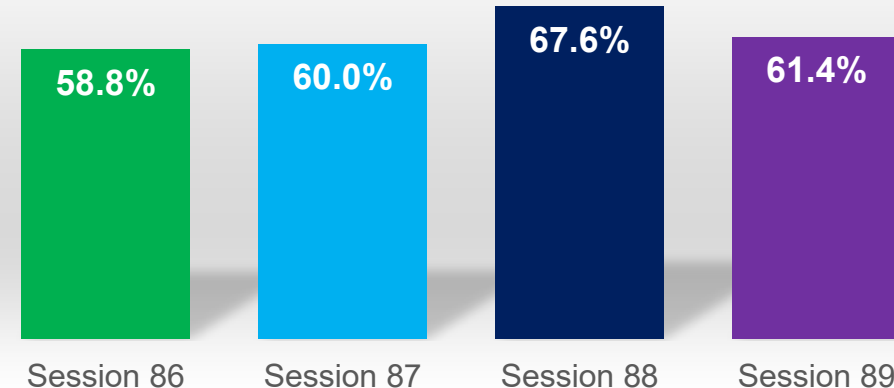
