



## Larceny Offenses


- Officer presence increased at malls during the November-December holiday<sup>1200</sup> season when retail crime historically increases.
- Springfield's Christmas Anti-Theft Team recovered over \$100,000 of stolen merchandise. In 2022, the team recovered over \$30,000 of stolen merchandise.


LARCENY OF MOTOR VEHICLE PARTS JANUARY - DECEMBER

- ≻188 Grand Larceny: Auto Theft arrest charges.




# **Reducing Pedestrian Fatalities**

FAIRFAXCOUNTY


- Proactive High Visibility Enforcement and numerous Traffic Safety Initiatives helped reduce pedestrian fatalities.

### PEDESTRIAN FATALITIES JANUARY-DECEMBER




# 2019-2023 Pedestrian Fatalities

- FCDOT, DPWES, FCPD, HD have started a collaboration to review pedestrian fatalities and significant injuries.




