TIMELINE

November/December 2016:

- January/February 2017:
 - Document and compare lines of business (budget, customers served, outcomes)
 - Benchmark research on regional and best practice organizations

March/April 2017:

- Gather feedback from shared customers and key stakeholders
- Highlight the work and focus of each of organization and benefits to customers and the community

May 2017:

- Identify areas of overlap, opportunities for improvement
- Develop collective goals and plan for working together going forward

June 2017:

Deliver recommendations to Fairfax County Board of Supervisors and School Board
