

- A Racial and Social Equity Resolution and Policy
- Commits the county and FCPS to intentionally consider equity when making policies, planning and delivering programs and services
- Involves community and stakeholder engagement, training and organizational capacity building, data analysis, collective planning and action, and shared accountability mechanisms
- Core questions:
 - Who benefits and who is burdened by past and current actions?
 - How can burdens be mitigated and benefits more broadly shared?






Equity is Fairness not Sameness

There is an "uneven opportunity landscape" in Fairfax County


- Reports from the Northern Virginia Health Foundation, PolicyLink, and Urban Institute and our own analysis document variances in opportunity and vulnerability within Fairfax County and across the Northern Virginia and Metropolitan Washington regions.
- The most effective solutions must be place-based and system-focused and address the spatial inequities that constrain opportunity and ensure equitable access to services and resources that promote economic mobility.

- Making sure materials collection represents the diversity of Fairfax County
 - Reducing barriers to service by eliminating overdue fines

Housing and Community Development

 Using vouchers to increase affordable housing choices in high opportunity communities

Department of Information Technology

• Maximizing broadband/Wi-Fi access

Office of Environmental and Energy Coordination

 Developing and implementing environmental energy programs that provide benefits to vulnerable populations

Fairfax County Park Authority

- Increasing to recreation/wellness opportunities
- Baselining the countywide distribution of park land and recreation facilities

Department of Procurement and Materials Management

 Disaggregating data to better identify disparities within the contracting and procurement processes and their root causes

Department of Tax Administration

 Adding payment options for people who are underbanked and unbanked

Department of Cable and Consumer Services

 Reviewing regulation and licensing requirements to eliminate barriers

Office of Strategy Management


 Building a care coordination service model with a focus on addressing disparities in health outcomes and evaluation methods to monitor progress




The Principle of Targeted Universalism:
