AFID: Governor's Agriculture & Forestry Industries Development Fund

New economic development tool just for agribusiness

- Grew from a discussion about how existing economic development incentives weren't working for ag and forestry – the State's largest industry
- Central question how to use a small pot of funding to have the greatest impact possible on ag and forestry?
- In November 2011, Secretary assembled stakeholders to develop plan, legislation creating program passes in 2012 with unanimous support
- Two programs: AFID Facility Grant and Planning Grant

AFID: Governor's Agriculture & Forestry Industries Development Fund

■ AFID Facility Grants

 Traditional economic development incentive grant program – like COF program

 State and Local incentives in exchange for a company's commitment to create new jobs, investment AND purchases of Virginia Grown products

FID: Governor's Agriculture & Forestry Industries Development Fund

- AFID Facility Grants Eligibility:
 - Application made by local government to benefit new/expanding business
 - Benefiting business must be facility that adds value to ag/forest products
 - Minimum 30% of ag/forest products used must be Virginia grown
 - Requires dollar-for-dollar local match (cash/in-kind)

AFID: Governor's Agriculture & Forestry Industries Development Fund

- AFID Facility Grant Amount & Conditions:
 - Max. grant: \$500,000 (most awards much smaller)
 - Requires performance agreement with clawback provisions
 - Grant amount determined by Governor based on a return-on-investment analysis, impacts on agricultural producers and other factors

AFID Grant Awards as of June 17

- Fifty Awards have been made totaling \$4,389,200.
- These projects will create 1,764 new jobs across 35 localities
- They will lead to \$395,229,897 in new capital investments and
- The purchase of \$378,313,219 of Virginia-grown products
- Representing 81% of total ag purchases



KO Distilling ~ Manassas

- Craft distillery expansion
- \$675,00 new investment
- 6 new jobs
- \$63,750 or 300 tons of net new purchases of Virginia grown corn, wheat and rye (100% of all grain purchases)
- Awarded \$25,000 AFID Facility Grant Aug. 16, 2016
- 1st AFID grant to a City in Northern Virginia
- City of Manassas EDA matched with \$25,000 local cash grant





Port City Brewing ~ Alexandria

- Craft brewery expansion
- \$2.68M new investment
- 26 new jobs
- \$41,000 of net new purchases of Virginia wheat and oysters (75% of all non-malt purchases)
- Awarded \$250,000 AFID Facility Grant Aug. 31, 2016
- 1st AFID grant in Northern Virginia
- Alexandria matched with in-kind, on-site transportation improvements and cash grant (unusual)



AFID PLANNING GRANTS

- Grants to Cities and Counties to better integrate Ag & Forestry into their economic development efforts
- Matching grants up to \$20,000 per locality (or \$35,000 for multi-jurisdictional applications)
- Dollar-for-dollar local match required, in-kind match (such as staff time) can be up to half of local match
- Requires the active participation of a local Ag and/or Forestry board, committee or working group
- Applications accepted on rolling basis
