

History

- Policy objective for many years
- PPEA RFP issued (2015)
- Two RFP responses
 - Stout & Teague
 - Comstock
- Public meetings
- RFP evaluated

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Council entered negotiations



Comstock Proposal





Comstock Proposal

- 281 apartment units
- Retail: 17,600 sf
- Arts Center: 18,000 sf
- Parking garage
 - 761 spaces
 - 1 ¹/₂ levels below grade
- 3 public plazas and a paseo
- Arts Walk

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Comstock Proposal





Goals

- Economically viable project
- Increase Public Shared Parking in garage and spur additional economic development activity downtown
- Arts Center and Arts Walk as centerpiece of downtown and Herndon Arts District
- Obtain fair value for property conveyed and limit Town contribution



Parking Garage

- 761 space parking garage
- 339 total spaces for public parking
 - 220 Public Shared Parking spaces
 - 60 for the Arts Center
 - 59 for Retail
- Free Public Parking
- Remaining spaces for residential use



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Interior of Arts Unit

- Delivery of 18,000 sf Arts Center as unfinished shell
- Interior design/buildout left to Town
- Town options:
 - Comstock contract for interior design
 - Comstock construction of build-out (5 percent development fee)
- Town may also procure either or both itself
- Exercising Comstock option lump sum or Guaranteed Maximum Price contract



Town Financial Commitment

- \$3.6 million to Comstock during construction
- Town payments
 - Not due until first draw on lender
 - Installments
- Arts Center build-out (TBD)



Financial Detail

Town Investment	Amount
Town Land Acquisition Cost	\$5.8 million
Town Cash Investment	\$3.6 million*
Arts Center/ County Contribution	\$1.2 million
Total Investment	\$10.6 million*

Tax Return	Amount
Town Ongoing Return/ Tax	
Revenues	\$.3 million annually
County Ongoing Return/Tax	
Revenues	\$.8 million annually
Estimated 10 year total return	
for the County (3% Growth)	\$9 million
