The delays extended the system's twelve-month warranty period, resulting in significantly lower than anticipated maintenance costs in FY 2001. In addition, the actual interest rate applied to the seven-year lease/purchase agreement was lower than anticipated. Therefore, the FY 2001 funding dedicated for these related costs will be carried forward to FY 2002 and will partially offset FY 2002 funding requirements for participating jurisdictions.
